Younger players get reps at 7-on-7 hosted by Fivay

Having missed the USF Sling and Shoot competition due to cancellation and without some key players absent at camps, many of the Bulldogs' younger players got chances to prove themselves Tuesday at Fivay in Hudson

The Bulldogs have certainly been busy this summer but they've been denied a chance to really mix it up in competition thus far. They didn't make the 32-team King of Kings Tournament a couple weeks ago. They were geared up for the USF Sling and Shoot but it got cancelled due somewhat to weather but more that the fields that they would have played on at USF were soaked. Undoubtedly, they were looking for some competition. That can be found most every Tuesday at Fivay High School in Hudson where a smattering of Pasco County teams gather every week to test their new passing plays and defensive schemes on each other.

Much of the Bulldogs' success in 2019 rides on the shoulders of

junior Nick Novo. Novo was noticeably absent Tuesday, away at a football camp. However, it opened up opportunities for that backup position to get some reps. The Bulldogs tried a trio of young players on Tuesday including, Timothy Jackson III, Gabriel Mathis and Raleigh Allen.

"We've got some new faces that are part of the program and we're putting them on a learning curve," head coach Nick Carroll said. "They did some good things, the quarterbacks have some mechanics to work on and the receivers need to learn distance and depth in their route running."

The Bulldogs got three games in on Tuesday against River Ridge, Hudson and cross-town rival Wesley Chapel. The Wildcats actually split their already thin squad into two teams and remarkably won all three games with both their A and B squads. The Wildcats' A squad just topped the Bulldogs in the final game with an interception on the final play. It's important to remember that the score is sometimes not even kept in these informal sessions. It's more about the work. It's also hard not to keep score.

"You get to see what some of their strengths and weaknesses are (when you play 7-on-7 against someone) but they get to see ours too," Carroll said.

Some fresh faces catching touchdowns was a pleasant sight. Mike Barber, despite getting called out for not making north-south

Summer campers cool off at East Pasco YMCA pool

Boys and girls in the city's summer recreation program get to swim twice per week

As is sometimes the case for this time of year, one recent swim session for boys and girls in the city's summer recreation program was cancelled due to a torrential downpour and lightning. A yellow school bus that pulled up to drop off campers at the East Pasco YMCA pool had to turn around almost immediately to bring them back to Stewart Middle, the camp's home base.

"They got there and lightning started, so they came back," program director Norm Scheuerman said from that school's gym. "I'm here with 80 kids playing board games."

The physical education teacher and coach was not the only one disappointed about a missed swimming day. Some of the children were not thrilled about the inclement weather either.

"It was very frustrating, because we couldn't swim," said Emma Calhoun, a 7-year-old.

On a brighter note, the young swimmers got into the pool two days later. The cancelled swim day happened on a Tuesday, but swimming is offered on Tuesdays and Thursdays through the summer recreation program.

Other activities offered at the annual camp that is now in its 43rd year in Zephyrhills are bowling, movies at Zephyrhills Cinema 10, indoor basketball and other games in the gym, as well as board games. Additionally, tennis will be added this year with that program beginning in mid-July.

Swimming, however, always has been a big draw for campers, ages 6-12. It started years ago when the pool at the former Hercules Aquatic Center

Children go hands-on with Dr. Seuss' Cat in the Hat

Interactive learning stations are part of city library's summer reading program for kids

The summer reading program hosted by the Zephyrhills Public Library is quite popular these days. So much so, in fact, that this year's installments for the nine-week series have shifted next door to council chambers at city hall.

"We're holding them at city hall, because we outgrew our building last year," said library director Lori Brightwell.

The summer reading program for young children to tweens kicked off on June 6 with a visit from members of the Zephyrhills Police Department, including the K-9 dog Bolt. Among the scheduled weekly activities, which last for about an hour, are the Selfish Giant's Garden Puppet Show, Silly Sam's Instrument Explosion and Lost World Reptiles.

The June 12 meeting, which featured a Dr. Seuss Silly Science Party, took place in council chambers. The late Theodor Seuss Geisel (1904-91) was an American children's author, political cartoonist, and animator who penned more than 60 books. He sold over 600 million copies, including such classics as "The Cat in the Hat," "How the Grinch Stole Christmas" and "Green Eggs and Ham."

"We never had a Dr. Seuss (event) before, but it was hands-on where the kids go station-to-station.

That morning there were actually two sessions with a day care group coming in before the other children, who ranged from kindergarteners to fifth-graders.

"If you're trying to do too many kids with the stations it's just too much," Brightwell said.

AdventHealth Zephyrhills is awarded Advanced Certification as a Primary Stroke Center



AdventHealth Zephyrhills has again earned The Joint Commission's Gold Seal of Approval and the American Heart Association/American Stroke Association's Heart-Check mark for Advanced Certification for Primary Stroke Centers. The Gold Seal of Approval and the Heart-Check mark represent symbols of quality from their respective organizations.

"AdventHealth Zephyrhills has thoroughly demonstrated the greatest level of commitment to the care of stroke patients through its Advanced Certification for Primary Stroke Centers," said Patrick Phelan, executive director, Hospital Business Development, The Joint

Commission. "We commend them for continuing to become a leader in stroke care, potentially providing a higher standard of service for stroke patients in its community."

A rigorous onsite review with experts from The Joint Commission took place at the hospital late this spring, according to Gwen Alonso, RN, AdventHealth Zephyrhills chief nursing officer. Joint Commission representatives evaluated the hospital's compliance with stroke-related standards and requirements, including program management and the delivery of clinical care and performance improvement.

"Although AdventHealth Zephyrhills has

been certified as a Primary Stroke Center since 2012, as a Joint Commission-accredited acute care hospital, the stroke certification is awarded every other year based on merit," Alonso said. "We work very hard to retain this certification and to continually improve. Stroke is a major health concern that we take extremely seriously. We have the clinical expertise and have invested in state-of-the-art technology. Our Stroke Advisory Committee, comprised of physicians and clinical team members from departments that include the ER, radiology, observation, and intensive care, measure response times and provide feedback and input on our clinical approaches to stroke patients," she added.

The American Heart Association/American Stroke Association have identified stroke as the fourth cause of death and a leading cause of adult disability in the United States, with someone experiencing a stroke every 40 seconds. In 2018, AdventHealth Zephyrhills treated 210 patients for cerebrovascular accidents (CVA), which is the medical term for a stroke, and 125 patients for Transient Ischemic Attacks, referred to as TIAs, according to Alonso.

A CVA, or stroke, happens when blood flow to a part of your brain is stopped either by a blockage or the rupture of a blood vessel, explained Deb Dungan, RN, AdventHealth Zephyrhills Stroke Educator. "When blood flow to the brain stops for a short period of time, this is called a TIA, and it can mimic stroke-like symptoms. These symptoms last less than 24 hours before disappearing, and are a serious warning sign that a stroke may happen in the future. You should seek immediate medical attention," Dungan said.

"AdventHealth Zephyrhills provides many free community presentations to educate individuals about stroke symptoms so they are prepared," Dungan added. "We use the acronym FAST because it's easy to remember and helps people determine quickly if there are stroke signs present."

The "F" in FAST stands for a one-sided facial droop, and the "A" is for arms. If someone tries to lift both of their arms and one drifts downwards, that's an indication that there's a problem, Dungan said. "With the 'S,' you want to listen for word slurring or see if the person can repeat a short phrase correctly. And 'T' means time, which is critical.

"If any of the F, A or S signs are present, you should call 911 immediately," Dungan said. "And if you think you may be having a stroke or you're with someone who is experiencing stroke symptoms, don't hesitate to go to the closest hospital and don't drive. Call 9-1-1. Paramedics are trained to provide lifesaving support while you're on the way to the closest ER."

Dungan recently started a stroke lifestyle group at AdventHealth Zephyrhills for those who are living with the effects of a stroke or a TIA. "The purpose of the group is to discuss daily challenges that participants may be experiencing, and our hope is that these individuals will find emotional and moral support through one another and learn coping skills that empower them," she said.

The stroke lifestyle group meets the first Monday of every month, 11 a.m.-12 p.m. at the AdventHealth Zephyrhills Wellness Center, 38233 Daughtery Rd. If you're interested in attending a stroke support group, call Dungan at (813) 779-6476 as reservations are required.

Tanci Mishler, a former librarian in Hillsborough County, set up the interactive stations that combined lessons in engineering, math, science and technology while connecting them with Dr. Seuss books.

"She's amazing, just a walking library," said Brightwell, who also was a former librarian in Hillsborough and has known Mishler for years. "She's the most passionate, real library person I've come across."

"She created all the toddler programs (at the Zephyrhills facility)," Brightwell continued. "She's the most passionate, real library person I've come across."

"I started doing these programs all over Hillsborough County, but now in Zephyrhills because I know Lori. We've stayed in contact since I left (Hillsborough)."

Dressed up with a red and white striped hat and a black top to play into the Cat in the Hat character, Mishler went station-to-station

to encourage and help boys and girls. The creativity, she reasoned, is something she always has enjoyed.

"It takes some time (to come up with ideas), but I've been doing this for a long time," Mishler said.

Among the children and families were several who returned for the second weekly activity in the summer series. Jennifer Lapoint of Zephyrhills brought her two granddaughters, 6-year-old Audney and Sadie, 6, and their little brother Grant, 2.

"It's good," Jennifer said of the library program. "It gives them something to do during the summer."

Sofia Hubert, an 8-year-old from Dade City, came with her aunt Amie Bliss, also of Dade City. Hubert won a goodie bag in a drawing that included several items. She liked the fidget spinner the best.

Hubert also relished the learning experience, saying, "We get to learn about Dr. Seuss. He had a lot of different kind of books."

Bliss concurred with Lapoint when she said, "It's just a great way for kids to get together and have something to do in the summer."

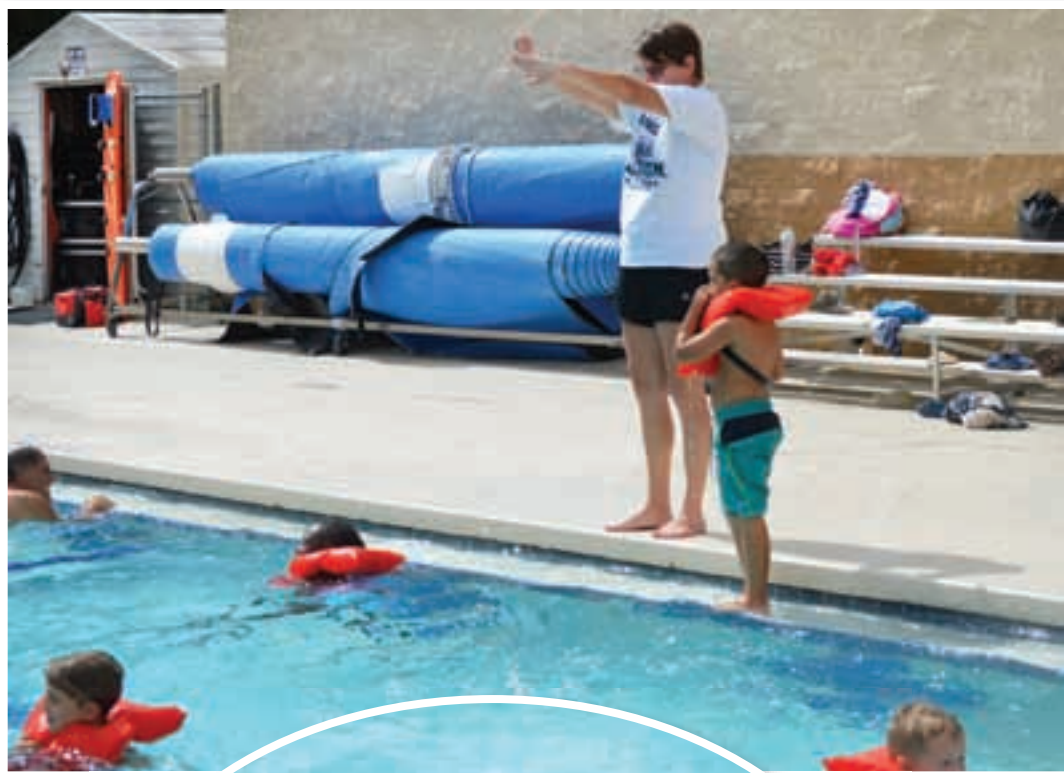

was open. That site will be demolished later this year.

Several young boys and girls said they liked swimming the best among the summer activities.

The Boggs siblings, 9-year-old Josiah and Elizabeth, 7, list swimming as their favorite activity.

"It's fun to do," said Josiah, who adds that he's a good swimmer, in part, because his family has a pool.

"I like the swim test,"

added Elizabeth. "You have to tread water for a minute and when they say go you have to swim from there to there (which she described as the length of the pool)."

Calhoun likes it for the physical fitness benefit, reasoning, "You get to work your body out."

Some campers in their first year attending the summer camp also spoke fondly of swimming at the YMCA's pool, which also offers various programs for children and adults.

"I like having fun and hanging out with my friends, and getting wet," said Jaidyn Hamblin, a 10-year-old who is looking forward to being in the sixth grade at Stewart Middle soon.

Another girl, 8-year-old Yaenoy Peyton who was wearing a life vest, enjoyed bobbing in the water, even though she said she did not pass the swim test.

In the water with the boys and girls was recent Zephyrhills High graduate Ethan Vest. The standout football player and state weightlifter who will be a freshman at the University of South Florida in August is working in the city's recreation program this summer.

His primary goal, he said, is to ensure that the youngsters "enjoy their summers."

On the pool deck as workers for the program were Emily Buckler, a teacher at West Zephyrhills Elementary, and Lynda Vest, Ethan's mother and the registrar at Stewart Middle.

"It's a good time and gets (youngsters) out of the house," said Buckler, who has helped out with the program for 12 straight summers. "We don't teach them swimming, but we do go over safety rules."

Vest, a former Zephyrhills High swim coach, actually worked with some of the boys and girls on showing them different strokes.

Vest said she thought there would be more campers opting to swim two days after the rainout, but said, "They didn't want to get rained out."

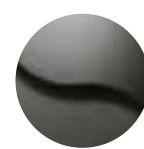

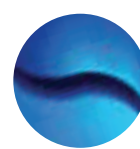
