## East Pasco Legends place second in first tournament

If the result of the first tournament played by a newly formed 10-and-under travel softball team is any indication, the future bodes well for the East Pasco Legends. Earlier this month they made it all the way to the championship game before barely losing in a Texas tiebreaker.

"They were upset," Legends manager Anthony Caruso said. "There were passionate cries. They really wanted it."

East Pasco led in the final by scores of 5-2 and 6-4 before the Central Florida Shine rallied to tie the game at 6 and eventually win by a nail-biting 7-6 margin. That left the Legends with a runner-up finish in the Gold Bracket of their division during the Sun and Fun Southeastern Fast-pitch Tournament at Kissimmee.

The Legends wound up with a 3-1 overall record for that series, outscoring the opposition by a 31-11 margin in the process.

They opened play with the first of two narrow victories by one run, 4-3 against Hatter's Gold. A dominating 19-0 shutout victory over the Fusion Fire followed that close game with the Legends then edging

## Kimley-Horn, Wharton-Smith tapped for Hercules Park greenlight

*The engineering firm and construction manager are set to break ground on the much-anticipated public park*

Hercules Park hearkens back to an idyllic time in Zephyrhills. In August of 1946, the Hercules Powder Company selected an 80-acre tract of land just north of what then was Zephyrhills city limits to start their operation. What became known as Hercules Powder Company Camp Number 39 began to develop. Hercules Powder Company had a processing plant in Brunswick, GA. that made all sorts of compounds like: paints, varnishes, adhesives, asphalt, emulsions, even gun powder and dynamite. Camp Number 39 was designed in order to remove yellow, first-growth pine stumps from land cleared in a 25 to 30-mile radius. At Camp 39, the stumps would be trimmed to a standard size and shipped, usually by rail, to Georgia.

It was never meant to be a permanent operation. Even Hercules representative E.C. Mann Jr. said in 1946, that the operations might last 15 years. It lasted 16 years. Yet the company would leave a legacy both material and immaterial. They built between 60 and 80 prefabricated homes for the employees to live in while the camp was in operation and housed 150 people. A culture grew up around it, even after the pine stump operation peaked. Softball teams, community cookouts, it became a social hub.

Harriett Morton Weicht from an Aug. 5, 2010 interview by Madonna Jervis Wise and Clereen Brunty recalled a more simple time, growing up in the area.



Zephyrhills, Pasco, Zephyrhills Christian, Wiregrass Ranch, Wesley Chapel and Cypress Creek begin preparing for the upcoming season

Seven-on-seven tournaments are over. It's time for the area's six high school football teams to bring full squads together to prepare for the upcoming season.

Zephyrhills and Zephyrhills Christian Academy coaches welcomed players, which for the first time included incoming freshmen, to their practice fields on Monday. Other teams that began practices as well were Pasco, Wiregrass Ranch, Wesley Chapel and Cypress Creek.

At Bulldog Stadium, coach Nick Carroll took the initial steps of getting his players ready for contact. The first

week of practice is focused on conditioning and drills.

"I want the effort to be 100 percent; finish drills," said Carroll, who is entering his seventh season coaching at his alma mater.

The Bulldogs, who have made the playoffs in seven of the past eight years, are coming off a 10-2 season. In this summer's 7-on-7 tourneys they finished in the sweet 16 of the Sling and Shoot at the University of South Florida and went 4-1 in Cypress Creek's tourney.

"We're getting better (in the skill positions, but I'm more interested in blocking and tackling over the next few weeks," Carroll said.

For now, the quarterback spot is a three-way battle with Brendyn Colella, J.J. McGovern and Tristan Lennon aiming to replace former two-way starter Jaxson Rivera.

At Zephyrhills Christian, coach Mike Smith stressed loyalty and unity after Tuesday morning's practice.

"If there's no unity then you're in trouble and we're not going to let that happen," said Smith, a former standout at Zephyrhills High. "We come to this field with no division. We stay together."

The Warriors are coming off a 9-3 season and won two regional games. The bar is set higher.

"I don't want to just make the playoffs," said Smith, who has guided the Warriors to two six-man state titles and five straight appearances in 11-man football. "The goal is to win a championship."

That optimistic outlook stems in part from what Smith deemed as one of the deepest and talented offensive lines he has ever had at that school, along with a handful of talented players at the skill positions.

"We probably have the best offensive line we've ever

had," he said.

New quarterback Parker Stirnkorb, a junior transfer from Dunedin, will be entrusted to lead the offense. As the varsity starter for the Falcons last season he passed for 2,026 yards with 21 touchdowns and 22 interceptions.

Caleb Gaskin, a former Zephyrhills Christian quarterback who has lined up as a slot receiver for the past two seasons, likes what he sees in the team's new signal-caller.

"I like Parker; the (passing) rhythm he has," said Gaskin, a senior. "I like the way he fits in."

In Cypress Creek's 7-on-7 tourney, the host had a varsity and junior varsity team in the field.

"Our JV played some tough varsity teams," Cypress Creek coach Mike Johnson said. "They didn't win, but they scored some points."

Each team got five preliminary games with the four-day series slated to include a championship round, but most of the latter games were cancelled due to thunderstorms. The Coyotes went 4-0-1.

As for player assessments, Johnson continued to be impressed with new quarterback Jack Niemann. Last year's JV starter is the heir apparent to two-year varsity starter Owen Walls, a 2022 graduate.

"I just think (Niemann) is going to continue everything that (Walls) put on the table," Johnson said. "He looked great. He was composed. He looked sharp. The ball was coming out of his hand nice. He just did everything we asked him to do."



## MOMENTS IN TIME

The History Channel

- On Aug. 4, 1753, George Washington, a young Virginia planter, becomes a Master Mason, the highest basic rank in Freemasonry. The ceremony was held at the Masonic Lodge No. 4 in Fredericksburg, Virginia. Washington was 21 years old and would soon command his first military operation. Freemasons trace the origins of masonry back to the erecting of King Solomon’s Temple in biblical times.
- On Aug. 5, 2002, the rusty iron gun turret of the ironclad warship U.S.S. Monitor is raised from the floor of the Atlantic, where it had rested since it went down in a storm off North Carolina during the Civil War. She sank in December 1862, while being towed from Cape Hatteras.
- On Aug. 6, 1911, Lucille Desiree Ball, one of America’s most famous redheads and beloved comic actresses, is born near Jamestown, New York. Ball starred with husband Ricky Ricardo on television’s “I Love Lucy” from 1951 to 1957.
- On Aug. 7, 1964, the United States Congress approves the Gulf of Tonkin Resolution, giving President Lyndon B. Johnson nearly unlimited powers to oppose “communist aggression” in Southeast Asia. The Johnson administration began heavy bombing of North Vietnam in early 1965 and sent U.S. combat troops in March 1965.
- On Aug. 8, 1945, President Harry S. Truman signs the United Nations Charter, and the United States becomes the first nation to complete the ratification process and join the new international organization. Although hopes were high at the time that the United Nations would serve as an arbiter of international disputes, Truman did not even use one of the ceremonial pens to sign, instead opting for a cheap 10-cent desk pen.
- On Aug. 9, 1936, at the Berlin Olympics, African American track star Jesse Owens wins his fourth gold medal of the Games in the 4 x 100 meter relay. His relay team set a new world record of 39.8 seconds, which held for 20 years.
- On Aug. 10, 1776, news reaches London that the Americans had drafted the Declaration of Independence. Until the Declaration of Independence formally transformed the 13 British colonies into states, the conflict centered in Massachusetts was seen as a local uprising.

# Wealth of Health

## The causes of hair loss and potential remedies

Hair loss became a widely discussed topic following the 2022 Academy Awards, when comic Chris Rock was verbally and physically assaulted on stage by actor Will Smith regarding a joke Rock made about Smith's wife, Jada Pinkett-Smith. Pinkett-Smith has alopecia areata, an immune system condition that attacks hair follicles and causes hair loss anywhere on the body. Pinkett-Smith now shaves her head to alleviate the patches of uneven hair loss attributed to the condition.

Alopecia is the clinical term for any hair loss that occurs on the scalp or body. Hair loss can be temporary or permanent, and is attributed to various causes. Anything from hormones to medical conditions to heredity can dictate if hair loss occurs in men and women. Baldness, according to the Mayo Clinic, typically refers to excessive hair loss from the

scalp. Hereditary hair loss is the most common cause of baldness.

Thinning, shedding hair affects both sexes, and sometimes is a natural side effect of aging. But not all hair loss is natural, and the following are some factors that can cause people to lose their hair.

- **Stress and illness:** Extreme stress or illness can cause hair loss in a process known as telogen effluvium, according to Dr. Michelle Henry, a New York-based dermatologist. Mental and physical stress can cause hair loss in the body to be arrested. When this occurs, the body sheds the hair. Hair loss can occur up to three months following a stressful event or illness. Finding ways to manage or limit stress can alleviate hair shedding.

- **Heredity:** Genes will dictate if a person has blue eyes or is tall or short. Genes also play

a role in hair loss. The American Academy of Dermatology Association says heredity can affect both men and women. In fact, hereditary hair loss is the most common cause of hair loss worldwide. Genes cause hair follicles to shrink and eventually stop growing hair. Hair loss may start in teenage years, but tends to begin later in life. There are medical treatments in the form of shampoos, lotions and even hair implants that can stop or slow hair loss. Some may help regrow hair. The earlier treatment is started, the better its potential outcome.

- **Alopecia areata:** Alopecia areata is an immune system disorder that attacks the hair follicles. Since alopecia can affect hair anywhere on the body, even eyebrows or eyelashes may fall out. Treatment may help stimulate regrowth. Doctors may suggest immunosuppressant drugs as well as a course of treatment.

- **Pregnancy:** Hormones fluctuate greatly during pregnancy and after. Giving birth also can be a physically traumatic experience that can sometimes contribute to hair loss.



Hair will likely grow back when hormone and stress levels return to normal.

- **Medications and supplements:** Certain medications, such as those to treat cancer, heart issues, gout, high blood pressure, arthritis, and depression may cause hair loss. Taking too much vitamin A also may cause hair loss. Adjusting dosage or trying different medications may help.

Individuals concerned with hair loss can speak with a dermatologist who can assess the situation and plan a course of treatment.

## Did You Know?

Individuals are urged to guard against sunburns and skin cancer by applying a sunscreen. But what does SPF and the various numbers associated with it mean? SPF refers to sun protection factor. The SPF rating, according to Verywell Health, refers to how long a person can stay in the sun without getting burned while wearing the sunscreen compared to how long he or she could stay in the sun before burning without wearing sunscreen.

For example, if you normally burn after 10 minutes in the sun and you apply an SPF 15 product, it will take 15 times longer to burn

in the sun, or 150 minutes (2.5 hours). Wearing a higher SPF product doesn't protect you better, it does protect you for longer durations. Therefore, you could conceivably wear an SPF 5 and with frequent reapplication, get the same level of protection as wearing SPF 45.

Higher number SPF products may be preferable since people can easily get distracted or forget to apply sunscreen regularly while outdoors. But experts recommend reapplication of sunscreen every two hours, regardless of the SPF number on your sunscreen bottle.






Above: Crew of the Hercules Powder Company dating back to 1946.

Above: Concept plan for Hercules Park.









"It was a different era—a time of safety in which you felt as though you had multiple sets of parents watching out for you. Your houses were left unlocked and keys in your car. It was a very secure place and a wonderful location to grow up."

The plant closed in 1962 but the legacy endured. Zephyrhills High School was built on the property in 1975 and Woodland Elementary in 1978. Ownership of the land bounced around between the Pasco County School Board and the City of Zephyrhills. Ideas floated and sank.

It now looks as if the remaining property is going to be developed into a community park. Don't roll your eyes. For real this time. The City of Zephyrhills has tapped construction manager Wharton-Smith, Inc. and engineering firm Kimley-Horn & Associates to design and build what will be known as Hercules Park.

The new park will feature a playground area, a 1-acre open play field, a more than 5-acre biking and walking trail, as well as a perimeter or "shell" trail going around most of the park. The choices to design and build the park were not arbitrary. The City of Zephyrhills has a professional services contract agreement with Kimley-Horn. Locally, Wharton-Smith has relevant experience with recreational park projects in the City of Clearwater, City of Sanford, City of Casselberry, and Seminole County. Meanwhile, the firm handled the 25,274-square-foot Woodland Elementary School addition, remodel and renovation.

In the 19-0 win, Bradley and Ireland Perry threw shutout innings. Caruso has coached softball in Spring Hill and Hernando County for the past 14 seasons. Recent case in point is Armie Hammer who, despite such successes as "The Social Network" (2010) and "Call Me by Your Name" (2016), was accused of sexual abuse in an anonymous Instagram post. Even though it was never proven, he was dropped by his agency and cut from co-starring opposite Jennifer Lopez in "Shotgun Wedding" (replaced by Josh Duhamel). Hammer also lost "The Offer" (replaced by Miles Teller) and was dropped from the series "Gaslit" (replaced by Dan Stevens), the film "Billion Dollar Spy" and a Broadway play titled "The Minutes." His role in "Death on the Nile" -- completed before the pandemic shutdown -- was impossible to reshoot, but Taika Waititi replaced him with Will Arnett in "Next Goal Wins."

Needless to say, Hammer's marriage fell apart, and when his wife, Elizabeth Chambers, moved to the Cayman Islands with their two children, he soon followed. However, Armie received no assistance from his famous family (you know, Arm & Hammer), so in order to support his family, he took a job at a Cayman Island resort selling time-shares from a cubby-hole office. As of now, no papers have been filed against him in any court, and no settlements of any kind were made. So much for "innocent until proven guilty!"

"The Fall Guy" was an ABC series from 1981-86 starring Lee Majors as Colt Seavers, a Hollywood stuntman by day and a bounty hunter by night. In 1981, Milton Bradley created a "Fall Guy" board game. A comic strip based on the series appeared in a "Look-in" magazine, and a British video game was developed by Elite Systems in 1984. In 2013, Dwayne Johnson was in talks to star in a film, but it never happened. Now, "The Fall Guy" will be a \$100-million film starring Ryan Gosling as Colt Seavers. But here's the catch ... this American-made series-turned-film about a Hollywood stuntman is going to be shot in Australia! The government in New South Wales is providing \$14.5 million, and the Australian Federal Government is ponying up \$30 million.

Paul Fletcher, member of parliament, expects "The Fall Guy" will inject more than \$244 million into the Aussie economy by employing 1,000 Australians who will make up the cast and crew, as well as over 3,000 locals as background extras. With those figures, "The Fall Guy" is a man for all seasons!
