Things were not going well for the home team in last week's junior varsity football game at Bulldog Stadium, but then it got a little wet. Zephyrhills trailed Wiregrass Ranch 34-0 at halftime, but the start of the third quarter was delayed when sprinklers came on along the visiting team's sideline.

"At least we got them with the sprinklers," Zephyrhills JV assistant J.T. Kirk said in jest.

Even that mishap, which only lasted for a few minutes, could not delay the inevitable as a team consisting primarily of freshmen wound up losing 47-0 to the unbeaten Bulls. The outcome might all of the sophomores on the varsity," said Zephyr-hills varsity coach Nick Carroll, who observed and assisted with the JV coaching staff on the sidelines.

Zephyrhills is now 1-3 with two straight losses, including a defeat at the hands of nemesis Pasco in the JV version of the 9-Mile War. Meanwhile, the Bulls are 4-0 this season, aiming for their second consecutive 8-0 season and have a 14-game winning streak dating back to 2017 when they went 7-1

Wiregrass Ranch actually wound up with a sweep of Zephyrhills this year. The varsity Bulls opened the regular season by defeating the Bulldogs. Ironically, both varsity teams have the same records as the respective JV teams.

'The weight room is going to be full this winter," Carroll said, expecting to see a lot of football players lifting often once the regular season concludes.

The Bulldogs held off two game points but the Coyotes prevailed 25-15. The Bull-dogs got back on track in the second game, moving out to an early 3-0 lead. Down 12-7 the Coyotes called a time out to re-group but quickly found themselves down 20-13. A few strong serves from Kyra Giles and the

Bulldogs won the second game 26-16. The final game that's played only to 15, saw a tight contest early but the Coyotes go on a 4-1 run to extend the lead to 7-4 and then 10-5. The Coyotes finished strong, win-ning the game 15-9 and the match 2-1. The Bulldogs couldn't hang their heads much as it was their first win of a game within a match in the regular season and they contested both games that they did lose.

It was up to the varsity teams next, teams consisting of seventh and eighth graders. The Coyotes were riding the JV's mo-mentum early as they dashed onto the court, breaking a homemade banner.



8-8 in the early going, a strong kill shot by Cypress Creek's Samarah Farias put them up 11-9, moments later. Coming out of a timeout, the Bulldogs knotted the game at 15-15 only for Cypress Creek's Melanie Rodriguez to drop in a service ace and make it 18-17.

The Bulldogs tied it again at 19-19 and put a two-point advantage up at 23-21. A service ace from Woolfolk made it 24-21 and the Coyotes fended off two match points but eventually fell 25-23 and then lost 2-0 in the match.

"I liked that we were behind four or five points and then battled our way back and played well until we won the set," Stewart head coach Debra Štacy said.

The win improves the Bulldogs to 1-1 on the regular season. "We played very well on Monday against Pine View as well," Stacy said. "I think both teams (JV and varsity) have improved by leaps and bounds. I'm very pleased with how we're doing so far this season."

Wiregrass Ranch hasn't just won this fall but done so in dominating fashion. Through four games the Bulls have outscored the opposition by a substantial 191-12 margin. All four victories have been shortened due to running clocks.

Coach Rick Oliver has been extremely impressed with a defensive unit that has posted two shutouts and eight touchdowns in four games, including three against Zephyrhills. Zyon Davis and Nick Kazmorck each ran interceptions back for touchdowns while Abdul Shehadeh added another defensive score on a fumble return.

Oliver also liked what he saw in the passing game as Davis completed scoring passes to Bryson Rodgers and Tate Hayes. He could've had another one, but Rodgers couldn't haul in a pass in the end zone.

"This is the first time we've really clicked in the passing game," said the coach, noting that the running game has been strong all season.

Wiregrass Ranch had the lone score in the first quarter against Zephyrhills with Kenneth

Walker running the football into the end zone from 5 yards out and Josh Depp following with the first of his six extra-point kicks.

The Bulls offense exploded in the second quarter, racking up 27 points for a 34-0 halftime lead. They tacked on 13 points in the second half.

Aside from his two touchdown passes and interception return for a score, Davis also ran for a touchdown. Robert Williamson added a scoring run and returned a punt for another touchdown.

The Bulldogs never made it past midfield in the first half and picked up their only first downs on penalties. Late in the game, they finally got a couple of first downs on offensive plays.

While two sophomores — quarterback Raleigh Allen and running back Willie Queen had the bulk of Zephyrhills' carries and were kept to minimal gains for the most part, backup Maddox Rivera had a couple of key rushes in the fourth quarter.

After Allen scrambled for a first down, Rivera kept that drive going with an 8-yard burst off left tackle for another first down.

Not long after that play, however, time expired.



Below: The Wiregrass Ranch offense lines up for a play against the Zephyrhills defense in last week's JV game at Bulldog Stadium.









Olender also was pleased with the way her volunteer-students helped with the athletes.


"I want them to get an appreciation out of who the Special Olympics athletes are and to see that they're not that different than people without disabilities," she said.
