## Beach volleyball makes its debut in Zephyrhills

### Sandy courts continue to bring unique sports to the Sarah Vande Berg Tennis & Wellness Center

Less than a month after beach tennis came to Zephyrhills, beach volleyball followed suit. Both sports debuted on four adjacent sandy courts at the Sarah Vande Berg Tennis & Wellness Center, which continues to bring new and different athletic opportunities to the area.

Heading up the beach volleyball program at the local center off Simons Road is Casey Winn, SVB's new director of beach volleyball who is a partner with Fernando Saavedra at Sand Life. That Seffner-based business has nine courts and offers year-round training and various programs for the sport.

With numerous tennis courts at SVB, along with courts for padel and pickleball, Winn met with Pascal Collard, the center's chief executive officer, and they worked out plans to convert a couple of tennis courts into sandy areas. That's where beach tennis was

played early in August and where a beach volleyball showcase took place last weekend.

"It was beautiful, but nobody really used it," Collard said of an outdoor tennis area.

"There's a vacuum of volleyball here," said Winn, who grew up playing beach volleyball on the state's east coast.

A combination of school-age kids and adults, many from Sand Life, showed up for Saturday's event. They took turns playing on four sandy volleyball courts.

"We just want as many kids to have the experience of playing," Saavedra said. "This just gives you another option. It's fun and the sand is so giving that you can play into your later years."

Added Jacob Crakow, a recent Armwood High graduate who has played for several years at Sand Life, "I think it's the sun. It's nice being outside."

While Saturday's showcase helped kick off the sport at SVB, eventually there will be tournaments — similar to the beach tennis tourney here in early August — and league play with various divisions.

Catherine Truehard, a coach at Sand Life, compared beach volleyball to the traditional indoor game: "It's really like a completely different game, but if you have the fundamentals of volleyball down it's easy."

## Poes lead Bulldog Cross Country at Pirate Invitational

The Bulldogs, led by siblings Madison and William Poe, turned out against some stiff competition at the Pasco Pirate Invitational in Dade City

Withlacoochee River Park, Dade City - In what would be the first competition of the 2021 cross country season for most runners, the Zephyrhills Bulldogs and Pasco Pirates mixed it up with some of the elite teams in the area. A very solid River Ridge boys team as well as Brooksville Central lead runner John Carbone dominated.

The Royal Knights carried the team title with 28 points to runner up Land O' Lakes with 78. Carbone won individually in 17:31 but got a good push from River Ridge's Chase Thurber (17:34). It would be Zephyrhills's William Poe chasing the leaders and turning in a third-place finish in a personal record 17:48.

The course at Withlacoochee River Park is a slow one by cross country standards. There are a couple of hills, some sandy areas and several sharp turns that drag down times but that also makes for an exciting run. The configuration was tweaked from previous meets, with runners coming back through the starting area for the final 800 meters or so of the race. William Poe, just into his sophomore campaign, has already established himself as the standard bearer for the Bulldog boys in 2021.

Despite the proximity to Pasco's home cross country course, it was still Poe's first competition on the course.

"I wouldn't say the course overall was hard but it did have two hills, otherwise it was mostly flat," Poe said. "It did have some turns that made it hard to pass but I would wait for the straightaways to pass people."

The course re-route was due to some fallen trees.

## Bulldogs open at home with 43-2 win over Hernando

Zephyrhills improves to 2-0 thanks to an opportunistic defense and a record-setting game by senior running back Jaylin Thomas

Coming off a road win over Lakeland Kathleen, Zephyrhills had its home opener Friday night and improved to 2-0 with a 43-2 win over Hernando. The Bulldogs and Leopards, who had a bye in the first week, had not met since Zephyrhills' 56-34 win in Brooksville in 2014.

This matchup was not nearly as high-scoring as that previous game, but proved to be just as dominant for Zephyrhills. An opportunistic defense forced four turnovers for the second game in a row and scored on three of those plays. The Bulldogs got a touchdown on special teams and Jaylin Thomas had his best game ever in their decisive win.

"That is a great step in the right direction," Zephyrhills coach Nick Carroll said, adding that his players "did a pretty good job getting field position and we were able to get some opportunities to score."

Next up is a road game at Fivay, which is off to a 1-1 start. Kickoff on Friday night is 7:30 p.m. Carroll warned the Bulldogs not to take the Falcons lightly during his post-game talk.

"We do not take any team lightly," said Carroll, now in his sixth season coaching at his alma mater. "We take them one game at a time."

Thomas, sidelined for the season opener while recovering from Covid-19, returned to the lineup in dramatic fashion, netted 254 all-purpose yards and scored three times. The senior running back returned Hernando's first punt for a 68-yard touchdown before scoring on runs of 56 and 37 yards. His first score gave Zephyrhills a 29-2 lead and the second closed out the scoring in the third quarter.

"I'm back, baby," said Thomas, who had a single-game career-high of

141 rushing yards. "It must've been those two weeks off."  
 "He didn't get to play last week, so he's been hungry to tote the rock," Carroll said of Thomas.  
 Following Thomas' punt return into the Hernando end zone, Zephyrhills went ahead 14-0 on Marcell Tucker's 30-yard interception return into the end zone of Hernando quarterback Blake Smith.  
 On the next possession Maguire Neal, who earlier recovered a fumble, tackled Smith in the end zone following a high snap for a safety and 16-0 lead.  
 Later, Tymar Mckever blocked a punt at Hernando's 25-yard line and ran it into the end zone from 10 yards out to give the Bulldogs a 22-2 lead.  
 "It popped right in front of me," he said. "I got like a gift."  
 Linebacker Theotis Smith also had a fum-

ble recovery for the Bulldogs, who limited the Leopards (0-1) to a safety when quarterback Jaxson Rivera was tackled in the end zone in the first quarter.  
 Rivera completed 5 of 14 passes for 149 yards, which included a 75-yard touchdown pass along the left sideline to T.J. Jackson, the former quarterback who Rivera replaced early last season.  
 Rivera also found Ben Raines on two pass plays for 48 yards, including a 43-yard connection for a key first down.  
 Combining Rivera's passing and a running attack that included 52 rushing yards by Willie Queen, who last week during Thomas' absence for the season opener in Lakeland took over as the primary running back.  
 "We moved the ball a little bit," Carroll said. "Offensively and on defense we want to be well-balanced so we can make plays across the board. I didn't know how we were going to show up and play because this was only our second game."

Added Winn, "It's a lot more strategy; like chess. You don't have to hit it hard, you just have to hit it in the right spot."

Kitana Lim, a tournament director with the Sunshine State Outdoor Volleyball Association, also showed up to help promote the sport and play a few games. She also offered a different perspective on the differences between beach volleyball and playing the sport on an indoor court.

"It's just a different vibe, listening to reggae and playing in the sand," she said. "It just doesn't get any better than this."

Among the other players from Sand Life and the Tampa Bay Heat were Jonathan Reysen, who has played the sport for a half-dozen years, and Truehard's sisters, Abigail Truehard and Victoria Brock. All three spoke highly of the sand courts at SVB.

"I think it's pretty awesome, with a lot of options," Brock said.

"We want to let people know there's a beach here," said Matt Ruby, who is with an investment group promoting growth at SVB.

Eventually, there will be housing for students attending an academy at that site. That would include, tennis, volleyball and soccer players as well as young students focusing on fitness and sports counseling.

Collard added that in addition to housing, plans call for an artificial beach area on the property. All of that promotion for beach volleyball would help foster an environment of athletics and academics. Especially in light of the fact college scholarships are available for beach volleyball as well as the more traditional game.

"One day we want to have a kid from Zephyrhills get a scholarship," Collard said.

Pirate sophomore Sawyer Ehman placed 34th, coming in just under 21 minutes and senior River Cole finished 35th in 21:15 even after losing a shoe on the course. Team-wise Zephyrhills and Pasco were second-to-last and last, respectively.

On the girls side, the Bulldogs were second-to-last and the Pirates did not even field a full female team. Yet, Zephyrhills' Madison Poe at least made the top 12. Poe battled nagging ankle issues but managed to gut out a 23:44 to become the top finisher of either school.

"I felt good for the first mile, I was staying up with the top three," Poe said. "But then my ankle started to hurt and I fell back. From there, it was just about hyping myself up, trying to tell myself it didn't hurt and hope for the best."

Pasco's Trystan Hanly placed 33rd overall in 27:05 for the next-best finish of an area runner.

The recent rains made for a wet course and placed fallen branches on the course as obstacles for the runners. Carbone of Central got out early.

"The Central kid (Carbone) was out of sight by the second mile," Poe said. "But I tried to keep up with the second place guy (Thurber) and protect my spot from the fourth and fifth runner."

Once the top three slotted in, that order would hold for the duration. Poe was by far the top Bulldog performance on the day. You have to look all the way back to 32nd place and Thomas Gianquitti's 20:49 for the next best Zephyrhills finish.

"I was super impressed with my boys today," coach Vinny Baez said. "This race was a temperature check for the team and our top five were all under 25 minutes. That's a good sign for the upcoming season."

Pasco's Seth Stringer had a great showing on Saturday morning, turning in a fourth-place finish in 17:55. The senior Stringer, was in his first race on the course at Withlacoochee River Park but benefited from training on the course for two weeks leading up to the meet. Stringer, also in his first year of cross country, comes over as the Pirates' top track 800 meter runner.

"We finally convinced him to come over here (to cross country)," Pasco coach Leeann Gates said. "He's built for it."
