About us

Choppards Mission is run by a group of volunteers. We are working to establish Choppards Community Association, to develop and maintain this much-loved building and surrounding area. Most importantly we aim to develop an affordable, fit-for-purpose and well-used community space.

The building

Choppards Mission was built in the mid nineteenth century as a Day and Sunday School. It had over a hundred pupils, who attended school half a day and worked the remaining hours. It is owned by the Church of England and administered by Holy Trinity Church in Holmfirth. A unique building, set in the stunning Ribble Valley, with views towards Cartworth and Holmfirth.

Upper floor – intimate room with windows overlooking the valley. Outstanding décor, designed and painted by Celia Kilner, Douglas Beardsell and Alan Lockwood. 7m x 4.5m. Seats 30

Middle floor – large hall with several windows overlooking the valley and exposed stone walls. 12m x 7m. A lovely, adaptable space but hirers please note that there are few electrical sockets at present.
Seats 80

Lower floor – kitchen and two washrooms

Access

Entrances front and side (both with steps). Roadside parking. Nearest bus stop (to Holmfirth and Huddersfield): about 700 metres away.
Nearest train station: Brockholes
