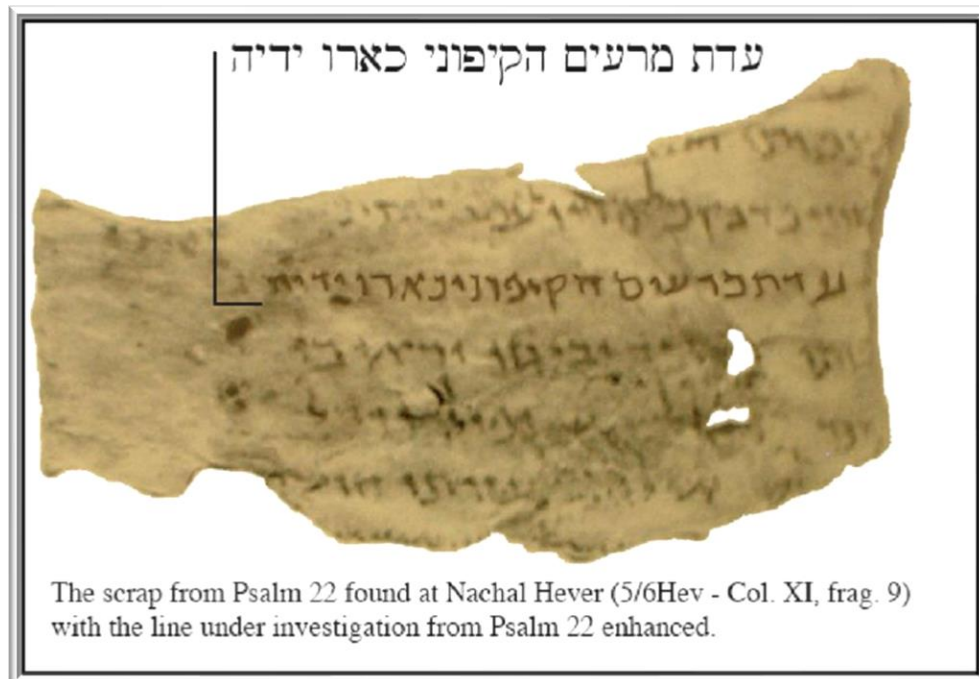
A collection of 150 songs and poems, that Israel sang to God (and to each other)—a type of hymnal for the ancient Israelites.

Psalms 68:19

"Praise be to the Lord, to God our Savior, who daily
bears our burdens."



TEACHER:

King David wrote most of the Psalms we love so much. Asaph wrote Psalms 50, and 73-83. He was a choir leader for King David, and a "Seer" according to 2 Chronicles 29. His sons would continue the legacy according to Ezra chapter 2. The sons of Korah are also contributors in the Book of Psalms. They wrote Psalms 42, 44-49, 84, 85, 87 and 88. These men figure very significant in revealing God's mercy. No teaching on generational curse is complete if you don't include the truths of their story. Korah had led a rebellion against Moses and was gathering a following that finally ended in a face to face confrontation. This is what Moses said to Korah.

"Moses said, 'this is how you will know that the Lord has sent me to do all these things and that it was not my idea: if these men die a natural death and suffer the fate of all mankind, then the Lord has not sent me. But if the Lord brings about something totally new, and the earth opens its mouth and swallows them, with everything that belongs to them, and they go down alive into the realm of the dead, then you will know that these men have treated the Lord with contempt.' as soon as he finished saying all this, the ground under them split apart and the earth opened its mouth and swallowed them and their households, and all those associated with Korah, together with their possessions. They went down alive into the realm of the dead, with everything they owned; the earth closed over them, and they perished (Numbers 16:28-35).

That was the end of Korah, but here we see Korah's sons, were spared (Numbers 26). God judged Korah and his allies harshly, but he still had a purpose and plan for his children. Seven generations later, the prophet Samuel was born from the line of Korah, the genealogy is recorded twice to prove the point. 1 Chronicles 6, 1 Samuel 1. His children would become doorkeepers and custodians for the house of God.

This shows Gods desire to restore families and break the generational curse. You are not a victim of your families curse! You can break the chain!

And your kids don't belong to you, they belong to God!

Originally Psalms were divided into 5 books. The Septuagint combined them. The ends of the 5 books are easy to find, as they are repeated. They are as follows.

1. - Chapters 1-41
2. - Chapters 42 - 72
3. - Chapters 73 - 89
4. - Chapter 90-106
5. - Chapters 107-150.

We will read something from every Psalm. If we do well, we can do this in 1 awesome evening. 150 Psalms. If a Psalm means something special to you, or you know a song, please share it with us as we go through this wonderful book together, otherwise we will read through, taking turns, watching the clock. If a heading for the Psalm or an event occurred, they are included next to "STUDENT:" and are edited from The Passion Translation. Take notice of these titles. Many are for the last days in which we live. Also note the versions. I used over 20.

CH. 1

Blessed *is* the man Who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly,
Nor stands in the path of sinners, Nor sits in the seat of the scornful;
² But his delight *is* in the law of the LORD, And in His law he meditates day and night.
³ He shall be like a tree Planted by the rivers of water,
That brings forth its fruit in its season, Whose leaf also shall not wither;
And whatever he does shall prosper. (NKJV, NEW KING JAMES VERSION)

STUDENT: **Messianic Psalm**

CH. 2

Why do the nations rage, And the people plot a vain thing?
² The kings of the earth set themselves, And the rulers take counsel together,
Against the LORD and against His Anointed, *saying*, ³ "Let us break Their bonds in pieces
And cast away Their cords from us."
"I will declare the decree: The LORD has said to Me,
'You *are* My Son, Today I have begotten You.
⁸ Ask of Me, and I will give *You* The nations *for* Your inheritance,

But know that the LORD has set apart for Himself him who is godly;

The LORD will hear when I call to Him. ⁴ Be angry, and do not sin.

Meditate within your heart on your bed, and be still. *Selah*

⁵ Offer the sacrifices of righteousness, And put your trust in the LORD. (NKJV)

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STUDENT:

CH. 5

The boastful shall not stand in Your sight; You hate all workers of iniquity.

⁸ Lead me, O LORD, in Your righteousness because of my enemies; Make Your way straight before my face.....

But let all those rejoice who put their trust in You;

Let them ever shout for joy, because You defend them; With favor You will surround him as *with* a shield. (NKJV)

O LORD, do not rebuke me in Your anger, Nor chasten me in Your hot displeasure.

O Lord my God, in thee have I put my trust: save me from all them that persecute me, and deliver me.

Get up, LORD! Get your fist ready, God! Don't forget the ones who suffer! (CEB)

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CH. 11

STUDENT:

I have taken refuge in the LORD.....

When the very bottom of things falls out, what can a righteous person possibly accomplish?

⁴ But the LORD is in his holy temple. The LORD! His throne is in heaven.

His eyes see—His vision examines all of humanity. ⁵ The LORD examines both the righteous and the wicked;..... because the LORD is righteous! He loves righteous deeds. Those whose heart is right will see God's face. (CEB)

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CH. 12

STUDENT:

Help, LORD, because the godly are all gone;

the faithful have completely disappeared from the human race!

² Everyone tells lies to everyone else; they talk with slick speech and divided hearts.

³ Let the LORD cut off all slick-talking lips and every tongue that brags and brags,

⁴ that says, "We're unbeatable with our tongues! Who could get the best of us with lips like ours?"

⁵ But the LORD says, "Because the poor are oppressed,

because of the groans of the needy, I'm now standing up.

I will provide the help they are gasping for." (CEB)

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CH. 13

STUDENT:

How long will my enemy keep defeating me? ³ Look at me! Answer me, LORD my God! Restore sight to my eyes!

My heart will rejoice in your salvation. ⁶ Yes, I will sing to the LORD because he has been good to me. (CEB)

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CH. 14

STUDENT

Fools say in their hearts, there is no God. They are corrupt and do evil things;

not one of them does anything good. ² The LORD looks down from heaven on humans to see if anyone is wise, to see if anyone seeks God, but all of them have turned bad. Everyone is corrupt.

No one does good—not even one person!..... (CEB)

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CH. 15

STUDENT

Who can live in your tent, LORD? Who can dwell on your holy mountain?

² The person who lives free of blame, does what is right,

and speaks the truth sincerely; who does no damage with their talk,

does no harm to a friend, doesn't insult a neighbor;

⁴ someone who despises those who act wickedly, but who honors those who honor the LORD;

someone who keeps their promise even when it hurts; someone who doesn't lend money with interest,

who won't accept a bribe against any innocent person. Whoever does these things will never stumble. (CEB)

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CH. 16

STUDENT:

Protect me, God, because I take refuge in you. ² I say to the LORD, "You are my Lord.

Apart from you, I have nothing good."

⁵ You, LORD, are my portion, my cup; you control my destiny.

⁸ I always put the LORD in front of me; I will not stumble because he is on my right side.....

¹¹ You teach me the way of life. In your presence is total celebration.

Beautiful things are always in your right hand. (CEB)

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STUDENT:

CH. 17

I cry out to you because you answer me. So tilt your ears toward me now—listen to what I’m saying!

⁷ Manifest your faithful love in amazing ways because you are the one
who saves those who take refuge in you, saving them from their attackers by your strong hand.

⁸ Watch me with the very pupil of your eye! Hide me in the protection of your wings,... (CEB)

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CH. 18

STUDENT: *composed when the Lord rescued David from all his many enemies, including the brutality of Saul*

He said: I love you, LORD, my strength. ² The LORD is my solid rock, my fortress, my rescuer.

My God is my rock—I take refuge in him!—

he’s my shield, my salvation’s strength, my place of safety.

³¹ Now really, who is divine except the LORD? And who is a rock but our God?

³² Only God! The God who equips me with strength and makes my way perfect,

³³ who makes my step as sure as the deer’s, who lets me stand securely on the heights,

³⁴ who trains my hands for war so my arms can bend a bronze bow.

³⁵ You’ve given me the shield of your salvation; your strong hand has supported me;

The LORD’s commands are pure, giving light to the eyes.

⁹ Honoring the LORD is correct, lasting forever.

The LORD’s judgments are true. All of these are righteous!

¹⁰ They are more desirable than gold—than tons of pure gold!

They are sweeter than honey—even dripping off the honeycomb!

¹¹ No doubt about it: your servant is enlightened by them;
there is great reward in keeping them..... (CEB)

CH. 20

We will fly our flags in the name of our God. Let the LORD fulfill all your requests!

⁷ Some people trust in chariots, others in horses; but we praise the LORD’s name..... (CEB)

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CH. 21

STUDENT: *For the end time, to the Pure and Shining One King David’s poem of praise*

Because the king trusts the LORD, and because of the Most High’s faithful love,
he will not stumble.....

Be exalted, LORD, in your strength! We will sing and praise your power! (CEB)

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CH. 22

STUDENT

I will declare your name to my brothers and sisters; I will praise you in the very center of the congregation!

²³ All of you who revere the LORD—praise him! ²⁶ Let all those who are suffering eat and be full!

⁵ Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies:

thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over.

⁶ Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life:

and I will dwell in the house of the LORD for ever. (KJV, King James Version)

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CH. 24

STUDENT:

The earth is the LORD's, and the fullness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein.

² For he hath founded it upon the seas, and established it upon the floods.

³ Who shall ascend into the hill of the LORD? or who shall stand in his holy place?

⁴ He that hath clean hands, and a pure heart; who hath not lifted up his soul unto vanity, nor sworn deceitfully.

⁵ He shall receive the blessing from the LORD, and righteousness from the God of his salvation.....

⁸ Who is this King of glory? The LORD strong and mighty, the LORD mighty in battle.

⁹ Lift up your heads, O ye gates; even lift them up, ye everlasting doors; and the King of glory shall come in.

⁵ Lead me in thy truth, and teach me: for thou art the God of my salvation; on thee do I wait all the day.

⁶ Remember, O LORD, thy tender mercies and thy lovingkindnesses; for they have been ever of old.

⁷ Remember not the sins of my youth, nor my transgressions: according to thy mercy remember thou me for thy goodness' sake, O LORD.

⁸ Good and upright is the LORD: therefore will he teach sinners in the way.

I have nothing to do with hypocrites. ⁵ I hate being around evil people..... I sing a song to give you thanks, and I tell about all the wonderful things you have done..... ¹² I am safe from all danger as I stand here praising you, LORD, in the assembly of your people. STUDENT: *David's poetic praise to God before he was anointed king. Messianic Psalm*

LORD, you are my Light and my Savior, so why should I be afraid of anyone?

The LORD is where my life is safe, so I will be afraid of no one!.....

⁴ I ask only one thing from the LORD. This is what I want most:

Let me live in the LORD's house all my life, enjoying the LORD's beauty
and spending time in his palace.....

LORD, hear my voice. Be kind and answer me.

⁸ My heart told me to come to you, LORD, so I am coming to ask for your help.

⁹ Don't turn away from me. Don't be angry with your servant.

You are the only one who can help me. My God, don't leave me all alone.

You are my Savior. ¹⁰ Even if my mother and father leave me, the LORD will take me in.....

Wait for the LORD's help. Be strong and brave, and wait for the LORD's help. (ERV)

CH. 29

The voice of our glorious LORD God is like thunder over the great ocean.

⁴ The LORD's voice is powerful. It shows the LORD's glory.....

¹⁰ The LORD ruled as king at the time of the flood, and the LORD will rule as king forever.

¹¹ May the LORD make his people strong. May the LORD bless his people with peace. (ERV)

STUDENT:

¹⁶ Please welcome and accept your servant. Be kind to me and save me. ¹⁷ LORD, I am praying to you.....

CH. 32

It is a great blessing when people are forgiven for the wrongs they have done, when their sins are erased.

² It is a great blessing when the LORD says they are not guilty, when they don't try to hide their sins.

So I only became weaker and more miserable. ⁴ Every day you made life harder for me.

I became like a dry land in the hot summertime. *Selah*

³ Sing a new song to him. Play it well and sing it loud!

⁴ The LORD's word is true, and he is faithful in everything he does.

⁵ He loves goodness and justice. The LORD's faithful love fills the earth.

⁶ The LORD spoke the command, and the world was made.

The breath from his mouth created everything in the heavens.

⁷ He gathered together the water of the sea. He put the ocean in its place.

⁸ Everyone on earth should fear and respect the LORD. All the people in the world should fear him,

⁹ because when he speaks, things happen. And if he says, "Stop!"—then it stops.....

¹¹ But the LORD's decisions are good forever. His plans are good for generation after generation.

¹² Great blessings belong to those who have the LORD as their God!

He chose them to be his own special people. The LORD looked down from heaven and saw all the people.

¹⁴ From his high throne he looked down at all the people living on earth.

¹⁵ He created every person's mind, and he knows what each one is doing.....

¹³ Then avoid saying anything hurtful, and never let a lie come out of your mouth..... (ERV)

LORD, oppose those who oppose me. Fight those who fight me. Pick up your shields, large and small.
Get up and help me! ³ Take a spear and javelin and fight those who are chasing me.
Tell me, "I will rescue you."..... ²⁶ Let my enemies be ashamed and embarrassed—
all those who were happy about my troubles. Proud of themselves, they treated me as worthless.
So let them be covered with shame and disgrace. ²⁷ To those who want the best for me,
I wish them joy and happiness. May they always say, "Praise the LORD, who wants what is best for his
servant." ²⁸ So, Lord, I will tell people how good you are. I will praise you all day long. (ERV)

STUDENT:

⁵ LORD, your mercy reaches to the heavens. Your faithfulness to the skies.
⁶ Your righteousness is as high as the mountains of God. Your justice is as deep as the ocean.
You save both man and animal, O LORD. ⁷ How precious is your mercy, O God!.....

STUDENT:

¹ Do not fret because of evildoers.
Do not be envious of those who do wrong, ² for like grass they will wither quickly.
Like green plants they will wilt. ³ Trust in the LORD, and do good.
Dwell in the land and feed on faithfulness. ⁴ Take pleasure in the LORD,
and he will grant your heart's desires. ⁵ Commit your way to the LORD. Trust in him, and he will act.
⁶ He will make your righteousness shine like light, your justice like noon.
⁷ Be silent before the LORD. Wait patiently for him.
Do not fret when an evil man succeeds in his ways,
when he carries out his wicked schemes. ⁸ Let go of anger and abandon rage.
Do not fret—it leads only to evil.
⁹ For evildoers will be cut off, but those who hope in the LORD will inherit the earth.....

STUDENT:

⁷ But now what do I wait for, Lord? My hope is in you. ⁸ Save me from all my rebellious acts.....
¹² Hear my prayer, O LORD. Listen to my cry. Do not ignore my tears, (EHV)

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CH. 40

STUDENT:

I waited patiently for the LORD; and he inclined unto me, and heard my cry.

² He brought me up also out of an horrible pit, out of the miry clay, and set my feet upon a rock, and established my goings. ³ And he hath put a new song in my mouth, even praise unto our God: many shall see it, and fear, and shall trust in the LORD.

⁴ Blessed is that man that maketh the LORD his trust, and respecteth not the proud, nor such as turn aside to lies.

STUDENT: *A contemplative poem for instruction, by the prophetic singers of Korah's clan (Psalms 42-49)*

As the hart panteth after the water brooks, so panteth my soul after thee, O God.

² My soul thirsteth for God, for the living God: when shall I come and appear before God?.....

¹¹ Why art thou cast down, O my soul? And why art thou disquieted within me?

Hope thou in God: for I shall yet praise him, who is the health of my countenance, and my God. (KJV)

CH. 43

STUDENT:

God, defend me. Argue my case against those who don't follow you.

Save me from liars and those who do evil. ² God, you are my strength.

Why have you rejected me? Why am I sad and troubled by my enemies?

³ Send me your light and truth. They will guide me. Lead me to your holy mountain.
