The Issues

Separation of Church and State.

The phrase “separation of church and state” is not found in the constitution, but rather in a letter from Thomas Jefferson to the Danbury Baptists. He was correct. This concept comes from the Bible. When God set up the nation of Israel under Moses, He made this distinction Himself. Moses ran the executive branch, and Aaron ran the priesthood. Moses did not function as a High Priest, Aaron did. Aaron had no executive power, Moses did. Aaron and others did council Moses such as Jethro (Moses father-in-law) Miriam, Joshua etc. with Moses making the final decisions. The problem facing us today is the Earl Warren Supreme Court began the nasty habit of applying the separation clause to the citizens of America Back in the 1960’s. The constitution was not written to limit the power of the American people, it was formulated to limit the power of the American government.

The Arguments and Responses:

“Our founding fathers wanted this to be a secular country with no ties to any religion. They intended for there to be no public display or mention of any religious reference or scripture. No laws or endorsement of a belief in God or any encouragement to seek such beliefs. They intended for us to be free from religion.”

We know this is not the case because the 1st Bible published in America and endorsed by Congress was the Aitken Bible in 1782. Often called “the Congressional Bible” Congress approved the translation and endorsed it as “The Bible of the Revolution”. On September 12, 1782, Congress authorized a resolution praising the work as a “pious and laudable undertaking” and recommended it to the nation. The resolution stated that Congress “highly approve the pious and laudable Undertaking of Mr. Aitken... and being satisfied... of the Accuracy of the Impression... recommend this Edition of the Bible to the Inhabitants of the United States”.

The endorsement helped establish the bible's reputation as a "patriotic" work during the war, meant for use in schools and churches.

“We are a secular nation, there should be no affirmation of religion in the public sector, especially from our government.”

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There are too many references to list of our founding father's public adoration of Jesus and His word. Here is a sampling.

Declaration of Independence: *Explicitly references "Nature's God," the "Creator," the "Supreme Judge of the world," and "Divine Providence".*

George Washington: FIRST PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

Frequently referred to "Providence" in his public proclamations and expressed strong personal belief in God's role in American affairs.

Benjamin Franklin: *Often spoke of a "superintending providence" that "governs in the affairs of men.*

Thomas Jefferson: *Despite being considered more of a strict separationist, he referenced the "Creator" in the Declaration and attended church services held in government buildings, detailed in this U.S. News & World Report article.*

John Adams: SIGNER OF THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE; JUDGE; DIPLOMAT; SIGNER OF THE BILL OF RIGHTS; SECOND PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES.

"The general principles on which the fathers achieved independence were the general principles of Christianity. I will avow that I then believed, and now believe, that those general principles of Christianity are as eternal and immutable as the existence and attributes of God.

Without religion, this world would be something not fit to be mentioned in polite company: I mean hell."

"The Christian religion is, above all the religions that ever prevailed or existed in ancient or modern times, the religion of wisdom, virtue, equity and humanity."

"Suppose a nation in some distant region should take the Bible for their only law book and every member should regulate his conduct by the precepts there exhibited. . . . What a Eutopia – what a Paradise would this region be! "

"I have examined all religions, and the result is that the Bible is the best book in the world."

John Quincy Adams: SIXTH PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES; DIPLOMAT; SECRETARY OF STATE; U. S. SENATOR; U. S. REPRESENTATIVE.

"My hopes of a future life are all founded upon the Gospel of Christ and I cannot cavil or quibble away [evade or object to. . . the whole tenor of His conduct by which He sometimes positively asserted and at others countenances [permits] His disciples in asserting that He was God."

"The hope of a Christian is inseparable from his faith. Whoever believes in the Divine inspiration of the Holy Scriptures must hope that the religion of Jesus shall prevail throughout the earth."

Called on the people of New Hampshire . . .

“Let us enter on this important business under the idea that we are Christians on whom the eyes of the world are now turned... Let us earnestly call and beseech Him, for Christ’s sake, to preside in our councils. . . . We can only depend on the all-powerful influence of the Spirit of God, Whose Divine aid and assistance it becomes us as a Christian people most devoutly to implore. Therefore, I move that some minister of the Gospel be requested to attend this Congress every morning . . . in order to open the meeting with prayer.”

Alexander Hamilton: REVOLUTIONARY GENERAL; SIGNER OF THE CONSTITUTION; AUTHOR OF THE FEDERALIST PAPERS; SECRETARY OF THE TREASURY.

Following his duel with Aaron Burr, in those final twenty four hours while life still remained in him, Hamilton called for two ministers, the Rev. J. M. Mason and the Rev. Benjamin Moore, to pray with him and administer Communion to him. Each of those two ministers reported what transpired. The Rev. Mason recounted:

[General Hamilton said] “I went to the field determined not to take his life.” He repeated his disavowal of all intention to hurt Mr. Burr; the anguish of his mind in recollecting what had passed; and his humble hope of forgiveness from his God. I recurred to the topic of the Divine compassion; the freedom of pardon in the Redeemer Jesus to perishing sinners. “That grace, my dear General, which brings salvation, is rich, rich” – “Yes,” interrupted he, “it is rich grace.” “And on that grace,” continued I, “a sinner has the highest encouragement to repose his confidence, because it is tendered to him upon the surest foundation; the Scripture testifying that we have redemption through the blood of Jesus, the forgiveness of sins according to the richness of His grace.” Here the General, letting go my hand, which he had held from the moment I sat down at his bed side, clasped his hands together, and, looking up towards Heaven, said, with emphasis, “I have a tender reliance on the mercy of the Almighty, through the merits of the Lord Jesus Christ.”

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One other consequence of Hamilton's untimely death was that it permanently halted the formation of a religious society Hamilton had proposed. Hamilton suggested that it be named the Christian Constitutional Society, and listed two goals for its formation: first, the support of the Christian religion; and second, the support of the Constitution of the United States. This organization was to have numerous clubs throughout each state which would meet regularly and work to elect to office those who reflected the goals of the Christian Constitutional Society.

There is no ‘gay gene’ Sexuality is complex, study confirms. Science Magazine Aug 29, 2019

There is no single gene responsible for a person being gay or a lesbian. That's the first thing you need to know about the largest genetic investigation of sexuality ever, which was published August 2019 in Science. **The study of nearly a half million people closes the door on the debate around the existence of a so-called “gay gene.”**

In its stead, the report finds that human DNA cannot predict who is gay or heterosexual. (*Notice here where they start trying to nullify some of the devastating consequences to the pro gay crowd.*) Sexuality cannot be pinned down by biology, psychology or life experiences, this study and others show, because human sexual attraction is decided by all these factors. (*All these factors? You just said there is no gay gene, which means the contributing factors of psychology and life experiences from the list they provided above are the culprits.*)

“This is not a first study exploring the genetics of same-sex behavior, but the previous studies were small and underpowered,” Andrea Ganna, the study's co-author and genetics research fellow at the Broad Institute at Mass General Hospital, said in a press briefing on Wednesday. “Just to give you a sense of the scale of [our] data, this is approximately 100 times bigger than any previous study on this topic.”

Moreover, the researchers found that sexuality is **polygenic** — meaning hundreds or even thousands of genes make tiny contributions to the trait. That pattern is similar to other heritable (but complex) characteristics like height or a **proclivity toward trying new things**. (Things like red/green colorblindness, freckles and dimples **can be traced back to single genes**). But polygenic traits can be strongly influenced by the environment, meaning there's no clear winner in this “nature versus nurture” debate. (*Notice how the left wing NPR spins this? The study makes it clear that there is no gay gene. NPR uses polygenesis to justify proclivities. In the nature versus nurture argument, nurture clearly wins.*)

It is worth keeping in mind that this study only covers some types of sexuality — gay, lesbian and cis-straight — but doesn't offer many insights into gender identity. In other words, the team only looked at the “LGB” within the acronym LGBTQIA+.

What the scientists did

The study set out to investigate a 20-year-old genetics debate in sexuality by combing through two huge collections of DNA profiles: the UK Biobank and 23andMe. With a reported 9 million users in its database, 23andMe is arguably the most popular, direct-to-consumer DNA testing company on the planet. The UK Biobank was established in 2007 by the medical charity The Wellcome Trust as a resource for research. It contains the DNA sequences of 500,000 middle-aged people, who were 40 to 69 years old when they were recruited between 2006 and 2010.

This study pulled the information for 477,500 people across the UK Biobank and 23andMe who had taken a survey about various life behaviors, including whether they had engaged in a sexual experience with a person of the same

sex at any point in their life. About 26,800 individuals — or 5 percent of the subjects — fit this description, which is similar to **the percentage reported across society more generally**. All of the subjects consented to this research, including those pulled from 23andMe's archives.

A GWAS study scans the DNA of hundreds or thousands of individuals, looking for common patterns that correspond with our health or our behaviors.

With this genetic trove available, the researchers conducted what's known as a genome-wide association study, or GWAS. As the PBS NewsHour [has reported previously](#), a GWAS study scans the DNA of hundreds or thousands of individuals, looking for common patterns that correspond with our health or our behaviors. Think of all of humanity as consisting of 7 billion copies of the same book. All humans contain the same words — or individual genes — that make up how we think and how our organs function. But the words in our respective genetic books — or their code — look slightly different. Some of my letters might be red, while some of yours are colored blue. They vary, which explains why we don't look exactly the same nor have the same health. This may sound counterintuitive, but those variations can also share similarities. The books that make up my family look similar to each other — in this example, they contain other shades of red. The same applies if two people have the same height or if we're both bald or if we're depressed. These genetic patterns look more similar among myriad types of groupings and that's what GWAS hunts down. The technique can be used to suss out why certain people (and their particular genetic variations) correlate with health conditions **like autism**, physical traits like curly hair or colorblindness, behaviors like handedness or emotions like loneliness.

What they found:

This GWAS study found that, like with many human behaviors, sexuality doesn't have a strong genetic backing. When the team looked for DNA patterns that had strong correlations, they found that no one gene could account for any more than 1 percent of people's sexuality. The strongest signals came from five random genes. Two of those genes correlated with same-sex sexuality in males, one of which is known to influence the sense of smell. One gene cropped up for females and two others showed solid patterns in both males and females. But their **individual scores never passed this 1-percent mark** — meaning they are all minor contributors if any to same-sex sexual behavior. **"It's effectively impossible to predict an individual's sexual behavior from their genome," said Ben Neale, a geneticist at Massachusetts General Hospital and the Broad Institute who led the study.** They did attempt to examine some elements of this continuum by conducting GWAS analysis on three smaller DNA databases wherein the participants had been surveyed using the Kinsey Scale. The Kinsey Scale is a somewhat infamous test for determining the strength of a person's feelings toward members of the same- and opposite-sexes. In other words, it tries to judge if a person leans gay, straight or bisexual.

The team found genetics cannot explain people's scores on the Kinsey Scale. Bailey did agree with Neale that the debate is now closed on whether any single gene is responsible for sexual orientation. "[Our study] underscores an important role for the environment in shaping human sexual behavior and perhaps most importantly there is no single gay gene but rather the contribution of many small genetic effects scattered across the genome," Neale said.

Polygamy:

The Story of Nehemiah (Rebuilding the Walls)

The account of Nehemiah highlights the physical reconstruction of Jerusalem's walls to remove the "reproach" of vulnerability (Nehemiah 2:17).

"But when I got back, I said to them, "Jerusalem is truly in a mess! The gates have been torn down and burned, and everything is in ruins. We must rebuild the city wall so that we can again take pride in our city."

It emphasizes dedication to the task (Nehemiah 4:6)

"The people worked hard, and we built the walls of Jerusalem halfway up again."

and the dual role of defending while building (Nehemiah 4:17-18).

"Who were rebuilding the wall. Everyone who hauled building materials kept one hand free to carry a weapon. ¹⁸Even the workers who were rebuilding the wall strapped on a sword. The worker who was to blow the signal trumpet stayed with me."

The completion of the wall is portrayed as a source of security and a testimony of divine help (Nehemiah 6:15-16).

"On the twenty-fifth day of the month Elul,^[a] the wall was completely rebuilt. It had taken 52 days. ¹⁶When our enemies in the surrounding nations learned that the work was finished, they felt helpless, because they knew that our God had helped us rebuild the wall."

Verses on Security and Borders

Other scriptures emphasize the importance of secure boundaries and safety.

Micah 7:11 (NIV): Mentions a day for "building your walls" and "extending your boundaries."

Psalms 147:13-14 (NKJV): Highlights strengthening gates and establishing peace within borders.

Isaiah 60:18 (ESV): Connects safety and security to the presence of walls.

Deuteronomy 32:8 (NLT): Focuses on God setting boundaries for nations.

Ezekiel 36:35-36 (NKJV): Describes fortified and inhabited cities as a sign of restoration.

Zechariah 2:5 (ESV): Symbolizes God as a protecting "wall of fire" around His people.

Verses on Vigilance and Protection

Proverbs 25:28 (ESV): Uses the metaphor of a city without walls to represent a lack of self-control.

Isaiah 62:6 (NIV): Focuses on the role of watchmen on the walls for constant protection.

2 Chronicles 14:6 (ESV): Connects building fortifications to achieving peace.

Psalms 127:1 (NKJV): Emphasizes that ultimate protection comes from God, rather than solely human effort.

We are right to defend ourselves.

Hate Speech (and hate speech is violence).

"You can't say anything that offends me."

And as if that isn't bad enough, compulsory speech.

"You must also use speech that affirms my feelings and my worldview".

The hubris of those statements is mind-boggling. The arrogance it takes to believe that you have the right to go through life and never be offended is unquantifiable. **Even God Almighty doesn't demand that.**

Jesus himself said in **Matthew 12:32** that

"Whoever speaks a word against the Son of Man, it will be forgiven Him..."

But this pack of woke lunatics actually think they have the right to not only tell you to stop speech that you feel is important, but now you also have to affirm and agree with their speech, no matter what your position might be.

Willful promotion of "hatred" is a criminal offence in Canada. Willful promotion of hatred means to make "statements" in public that willfully or intentionally promote hate against an "identifiable group." Unlike public incitement of hatred, willful promotion of hatred does not have to involve a breach of the peace. **BC's office of Human Rights Commissioner. Now it is held that if I disagree with you, I hate you!**

Mark my words, the next phase of this law's progression will be the Gospel message will be outlawed in Canada. Ministers in Canada are already banned from preaching against homosexuality, and more is coming down the pike shortly. **The next stop on that little train ride will be America.** *(For research on Canada's hate speech laws see Canadian criminal law Bill C-63, section 318, 319(1), 319(2), and the On-line harms act.)*

The Environment:

Ideological Positioning: Environmental care is often treated as a left-wing issue, allowing conservatives to align against it to strengthen their political identity. The mistake being made we need to make this a conservative position. God gave us a wonderful planetary home; we should appreciate it. That was the task God gave Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden.

"Creation Care" Conflict: While many religions emphasize stewardship, some conservative religious groups, particularly evangelicals, have moved from supporting stewardship to climate skepticism and opposing environmental regulation. We must prepare ourselves better regarding the lies often center in the environmental scientific discussions. The fraud in science is taking money away from actual conservation projects.

Discourse of Skepticism: Apologetics often frame environmental impacts as far away in time or place (e.g., polar bears, foreign countries) to minimize concern within the U.S.A. Rather than denying all environmental issues as bogus we should turn the discussion toward real environmental projects. Follow the money.

Reclaiming Conservatism: Some, including conservative leaders, argue that conservation is inherently conservative, citing Russell Kirk and Ronald Reagan to link protection of natural resources with protecting heritage. This should be a religious discussion.

Framing Matters: Research suggests that using "binding morality" (e.g., patriotism, local stewardship) rather than global "care" framing can increase conservative support for environmental action. Real science results in real results.

Slavery is a part of our History and the Bible seems to be in its favor:

“The Bible is pro-slavery.”

It’s an accusation commonly charged by the new atheists against believers in Christ today. It is often the first bullet fired against the church in a debate on the inspiration of scripture.

“How can the Bible be inspired by an all-powerful loving God and get slavery wrong?”

It is an honest question. It also has some apparent, face-value support, and not just in the Old Testament, but in New Testament epistles written by both Paul and Peter.

Ephesians 6:5: “Bondservants, obey your earthly masters.”

Colossians 3:22: “Bondservants, obey in everything those who are your earthly masters.”

1 Peter 2:18: “Servants, be subject to your masters.”

How should Christians respond to this concern? It’s a complicated and sensitive issue that we will answer here.

When we are discussing slavery in 21st century western cultured Christianity we are typically talking about the **Atlantic Slave Trade**. The technical term for this is **chattel slavery**. Chattel slavery is forbidden in the Bible.

“Whoever steals a man and sells him, and anyone found in possession of him, shall be put to death.”
Exodus 21:16

“The Law was written for people who are sexual perverts or who live as homosexuals or are kidnappers or liars or won’t tell the truth in court. It is for anything else that opposes the correct teaching.”
1st Timothy 1:10

Chattel Slavery is kidnapping someone, for forced labor or to sell to someone for forced labor, or transporting someone for the same. The Bible prescribes the death penalty for all three. Slavery is out-lawed in scripture.

When the word slave is mentioned in the Bible, it is referring to **indentured servitude**. We will use Onesimus as our example of indentured servitude from the book of Philemon.

Philemon was a wealthy Christian from Asia Minor, married to Apphia, and the two of them set up a church in their home after Paul led them both to Christ. According to early church records, they were martyred when Nero killed many in the church at Colossae during the 1st general persecution of the Christians. Philemon headed the church in Gaza up to that point. Onesimus was the indentured servant of Philemon by mutual agreement.

The reason Paul was writing to Philemon was Paul had converted a gentleman named Onesimus to Christ. Paul would soon find out that Onesimus was the runaway slave of Paul’s friend Philemon. It is important to note that this was not slavery as we think of slavery in our history in America. This was a case of indentured servitude. Indentured servitude was a voluntary, or sometimes court ordered servanthood to pay off a debt. If one’s family was poor, you could hire yourself on as a servant to a rich family, work for several years and receive a lump sum, or have your debts paid when the service was completed. Onesimus ran from his obligation before the debt was paid. Indentured servitude also was used to pay for higher education, paying for land or travel etc. According to Leviticus this type of agreement between two parties could not extend past seven years.

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The Greek word (*doulos*) can be translated “slave,” or sometimes “servant” or “bondservant,” and often referred to people who had a surprising level of legal and social status in the first-century Greco-Roman world. Most were not “slaves” from their birth, or for their whole life, or because of their race—for instance, the Roman jurist Gaius (second century) claimed that most slaves were prisoners of war who actually would have been slaughtered if not made slaves.

In conclusion the Old Testament, freed slaves every seventh year (**Ex. 21:2**), commanded the death penalty for manstealing (**Ex. 21:16**), and generally sought to limit the institution in protection of the slave. Further, slavery was generally not organized by race but by circumstance and economics (for example, foreigners, debtors, and so on). To be clear, slavery in any sense perverts God’s created intention for human beings.

Top Policy Priorities

Economy & Inflation: Republicans prioritize lowering inflation, reducing taxes, decreasing government spending, and boosting economic growth.

Key Biblical Principles & Verses on Financial Restraint

Contentment vs. Greed: 1 Timothy 6:6-9 indicates that godliness with contentment is true wealth, advising against chasing money. Hebrews 13:5 warns, "Keep your life free from love of money, and be content with what you have".

The Danger of Debt: Proverbs 22:7 advises that "the borrower is slave to the lender," highlighting the loss of freedom associated with debt.

Diligence and Planning: Proverbs 21:5 states, "The plans of the diligent lead to profit as surely as haste leads to poverty," highlighting the need for careful financial strategy. Proverbs 13:11 notes, "Wealth won quickly dwindles away, but gathered little by little, it grows".

Avoid Excessive Spending: Proverbs 21:17 warns that those who love pleasure and luxury will become poor.

Stewardship and Savings: Proverbs 21:20 highlights that "In the house of the wise are stores of choice food and oil, but a foolish man devours all he has".

Budgeting: Luke 14:28-30 encourages "counting the cost" before starting projects to avoid unfinished ventures and foolish, unplanned spending.

Spiritual Focus: Matthew 6:19-21 advises against storing up earthly treasures, which are vulnerable to loss, and suggests investing in spiritual, eternal treasures.

Immigration & Border Security: A top concern is securing the U.S.-Mexico border, decreasing illegal immigration, and implementing stricter immigration policies.

Key Scriptural Principles on Borders:

God Established Boundaries: Scripture states that God determined the boundaries of nations. *“When the Most High gave to the nations their inheritance... he fixed the borders of the peoples” (Deuteronomy 32:8).*

Purpose of Borders: Biblical borders, such as those mentioned in Numbers 34:1–12, provided security, defined jurisdictions, and maintained national identity.

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Fortified Walls: The Bible mentions physically fortified cities with gates and bars (Deuteronomy 3:5, 2 Chronicles 14:6-7).

Orderly Entry & Citizenship: Moses requested permission to pass through territories, respecting their borders (Numbers 20:17). The Bible highlights the distinction between citizens and foreigners (nokri) who did not assimilate.

Crime & Safety: Emphasizing "law and order," the party focuses on backing law enforcement, reducing crime rates, and supporting stricter penalties.

Key Biblical Verses on Safety and Protection

Psalms 91:1-16: Abiding under the shadow of the Almighty provides protection from dangers.

Proverbs 18:10: "The name of the LORD is a strong tower: the righteous runneth into it, and is safe".

Psalms 4:8: "I will both lay me down in peace, and sleep: for thou, LORD, only makest me dwell in safety".

Psalms 23:4: "Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will fear no evil, for You are with me".

Isaiah 54:17: "No weapon that is fashioned against you shall succeed, and you shall refute every tongue that rises against you in judgment".

Proverbs 29:25: "Fear of man will prove to be a snare, but whoever trusts in the Lord is kept safe".

National Security & Foreign Policy: Focused on maintaining a strong military, "peace through strength," and addressing national security threats.

These verses reflect the importance of strategy, counsel, and readiness, including the establishment of fortifications and, in some contexts, preparation for physical defense.

Psalms 144:1, Blessed be the LORD, my rock, who trains my hands for war, and my fingers for battle;

Proverbs 11:14, Where there is no guidance, a people fall, but in an abundance of counselors there is safety.

Nehemiah 4:14, And I looked and arose and said to the nobles and to the officials and to the rest of the people, "Do not be afraid of them. Remember the Lord, who is great and awesome, and fight for your brothers, your sons, your daughters, your wives, and your homes."

Numbers 32:17, but we will take up arms, ready to go before the people of Israel, until we have brought them to their place. And our little ones shall live in the fortified cities because of the inhabitants of the land.

Luke 22:36, He said to them, "But now let the one who has a moneybag take it, and likewise a knapsack. And let the one who has no sword sell his cloak and buy one.

Energy Independence: Advocating for increased domestic oil and gas production to lower energy costs.

While this is a rather modern problem and doesn't easily fall in the Biblical timeframe, there are many verses in scripture that hold to the principle of self-reliance on a personal level. Here's one:

2 Thessalonians 3:10 (ESV): "...If anyone is not willing to work, let him not eat."

Where we can improve our platform and message:

Biblical verses on social issues emphasize justice, care for the marginalized, and fair treatment of the poor and vulnerable. This discussion always is sidetracked when the left applies these principles to people who are self-marginalized. People who are marginalized because of their own criminal or perverted behavior. Truly marginalized members of society are not poor people for example, who engage in criminal behavior, but poor people who don't. Not a guy that wears lip stick and heels, but inter-sex people with two x chromosomes and one y chromosome.

Key themes include:

Protecting orphans and widows, (why is abortion so cheap, and adoption so expensive?)
Welcoming legal immigrants, and demanding fairness from the powerful, (why does no one rich or powerful ever go to jail?).

Prominent passages include:

Micah 6:8: calling to "do justice, love kindness."

Matthew 25:31-46: which links serving the needy with serving God.

Habakkuk: The entire book of Habakkuk deals with just this subject.

Justice and Advocacy:

Proverbs 31:8-9: Commands speaking up for the destitute and defending the rights of the poor.

Isaiah 1:17: Directs to "seek justice, correct oppression; bring justice to the fatherless, and please the widow's cause".

Amos 5:24: "But let justice roll down like waters, and righteousness like an ever-flowing stream".

Jeremiah 22:3: Urges acting with justice and protecting the vulnerable from oppression.

Election Integrity: Promoting policies aimed at strengthening the security of election processes.

Maintaining Election Integrity from a Biblical Perspective (from our friends at well versed world).

Election integrity is the foundation stone on which representative government rests. With it, participants in the political process can have confidence that their elected leaders actually represent what the public wants. Without it, the voting public quickly becomes cynical and will rarely see an "elected" leader as having legitimacy.

In a nutshell, if you have election integrity, you have confidence that election results accurately reflect the informed voting decisions made by legitimate voters. While there are many biblical examples of appointing leaders (i.e., Exodus 18:19-22; Deuteronomy 16:18; Acts 14:23), the Bible doesn't directly address voting in the same sense that modern elections are conducted. There are, however, biblical principles that if followed would help ensure elections are valid (i.e., honest and trustworthy), and yield results the voting public can have confidence in. The following lists some of those principles.

One person, one vote - Genesis 1:27: Everyone is made in God's image and therefore has intrinsic value and worth. This value is independent of social status, amount of wealth, race, ethnicity, country of origin, or even what faith a person has. In effect, voting is the great leveler among people. This basis principle is violated whenever one person votes multiple times, or a vote is duplicated or falsified or bought, or when votes are not counted.

Who Should Be Allowed To Vote?

You should be an Adult - 1 Corinthians 13:11: Although our nation has decided that a person is mature enough to vote when they're 18 or older, biblically being 20 years of age appears to be more aligned with adulthood. For instance, a person had to be at least 20 years old to serve in the military (Numbers 1:3), be counted in a national census (Numbers 1:2-3), to bring offerings to the Temple (Exodus 30:14), and to be personally accountable for major sins (Numbers 14:29-30; 32:11). Although biblical adulthood at 20 years of age appears more prudent than 18, any attempt to lower it even further (i.e. 17 or 16) appears unwarranted and ill-conceived.

You should be of sound mind - Matthew 5:37: A voting decision is in a sense a vow that that decision represents what we sincerely intend. The biblical equivalent is letting our "Yes be Yes" and our "No be No." Vows are serious matters, implying we understand the gravity of our decision and that it is a legitimate reflection of our desires. Filling out a ballot for someone that is not cognitive or able to think clearly for themselves is in effect stealing their vote and exploiting the defenseless and weak (Proverbs 22:22), which is strongly condemned biblically.

Proof of Identification - Philemon 19: In Biblical times, kings authenticated their personal approval by imprinting their seal on a document (Esther 8:10). The Apostle Paul validated his authorship of the letter to Philemon by using his own, easily identifiable handwriting (see also Galatians 6:11; 2 Thessalonians 3:17). Being able to personally authenticate a document has always been extremely important. No less important is being able to prove who you are when you cast a vote. Therefore, the use of signature verification and/or government issued identification appears to be a prudent minimum requirement. Falsely identifying as someone else is a violation of this principle (1 Kings 21:8) and is a false witness (Exodus 20:16).

Simple Process - 1 Corinthians 14:33: The Bible tells us we serve a God of order, not confusion. When the voting process is unnecessarily complicated, confusing, subject to interpretation, extends over long periods of time, has multiple paths with numerous third parties handling the ballot before counting, and has a loose (or even partisan) chain of custody, it will be open to easy manipulation and fraud. Returning to a simplified voter and vote accounting system would reduce complexity and allow for proper accountability, similar to the Old Testament need for a simple temple "lock-box" that eliminated theft and kept the system of tithes and offerings secure (2 Kings 12:4-12).

Obey the Rules - 2 Timothy 2:5: Voting rules should be easy to understand and then enforced. Just as athletes who don't follow the rules should be disqualified because they are misrepresenting themselves, so purposeful violations of voting requirements should result in ballot and voting disqualification in order to maintain election integrity.

Citizenship - Exodus 12:24-27; Ezekiel 44:9: Biblically, native born citizens and foreigners were treated the same under civil laws (Exodus 12:49; Numbers 15:15-16). However, to be fully recognized as part of the nation of Israel, foreigners had to show fidelity to national purpose (Exodus 12:48) and recognition of transcendent values and beliefs (Ezekiel 44:6-7). The same loyalty significance applies today. To directly participate in the governing of our nation, a foreigner must show commitment (citizenship) towards our values and what our nation represents. To let loose voter registration processes allow non-citizens to vote trivializes the high privilege and duty of voting and creates significant opportunities for abuse.

Independent Verification - Proverbs 18:17: Proverbs says: "One man seems right until another man questions him." All elections are by nature partisan. Limiting open accountability and transparency for competing interests to verify election integrity throughout the entire election process in an open invitation for election fraud. Resolving any discrepancies that are found must also be done in a just and fair manner, otherwise any transparency is futile (Proverbs 21:15).

The three most common complaints against the Gospel message are:

1. The Gospel is selfish.
2. The Gospel is naïve.
3. The Gospel is impotent.

So, what is the answer? What can we do as a church? The Bible offers 1 solution.

"If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

Now mine eyes shall be open, and mine ears attend unto the prayer that is made in this place."

2 Chronicles 7:14-15
