



The 10 commandments

Make a fist for the Sun, the curve of the thumb is the Moon, hold up 4 fingers and twinkle them for the Stars.

Hold up 5 fingers to make an animal crawling around with 1 hand and 1 finger up with the other hand to make Adam. God made Animals and People.






Grab 2 fingers to symbolize laying on a pillow. God rested on the 7th Day.



The Biggest Attack Against Atheism:

The Biggest Argument in The Existence of God:

Evil, pain and injustice are so prevalent in the world, that if God exists, He cannot be all-powerful, all-knowing, and all-good at the same time.

We as Christians believe that if **God is love** as 1 John 4 teaches, then we must have freewill. If we have no choice in who we love, but are forced, then it is not truly love. It follows then logically, the possibility to reject loving God, and His love for us, must allow for evil to *at least* exist.



The Sheer Number of Manuscripts, All of Which are Non-Contradictory, Validate its Chain of Custody.

Every Greek historian will quote Aristotle, for instance, with authority. Yet, we only possess 5 copies of his work dated at the earliest, 1100 years after he wrote them. We only possess 210 manuscripts from Plato's work dated 1400 years after the fact. They are both quoted as fact routinely around the world every day.

We have close to 25,000 manuscripts of scripture dating from 117AD – 300AD. You can argue if you believe it or not as far as telling the truth, but not that it is accurate as having truthfully been preserved. That is undeniable. With so many fragments agreeing, but not one corrupt, the burden of proof falls on those who doubt its reliability.



The Biggest Argument Against the Bible Being Inspired by God Is, "Extra-Ordinary Claims require Extra-Ordinary Proof".

As a Christian, I agree. Where I depart from the non-believer is, I have read it before I decided for myself. Several thousand years before science discovered these truth's the Bible proclaimed:

The Earth is floating in Space. Job 26:7

The Earth is Spinning. Job 38:14

The Earth is round. Isaiah 40:22a

The Universe is expanding. Isaiah 40:22b

The Hydrologic Cycle. Job 36:27-28

Add to this list the **fulfilled prophesies, messianic prophesies, equidistant letter sequences, and medical instruction**, there can be no doubt to the reasonable person that God has inspired this book.



The Level of Secular Scholarship is Replete To Such An Extent With Corroboration That Few Deny Jesus Existed As A Historical Person. These Are The Secular Mentions That Are Most Often Quoted.

Tacitus: 55AD – 118AD Josephus: 37AD – 100AD Celsus: Early 2nd Century C175AD

Pliny: 61-113AD Suetonius: 49AD Mara Bar Serapion: 1st Century

Mishna Letter: 200AD

OLD TESTAMENT VERSE FOR THE TRINITY

WHY?

AS A BOARD MEMBER OF A CHURCH IN OHIO FOR MANY YEARS ONE OF MY DUTIES WAS TO CALL PEOPLE WHO MISSED FOR SEVERAL WEEKS IN A ROW TO SEE IF THEY WERE OK.

THOSE THAT DECIDED THE CHURCH WAS NO LONGER A PASSION, OR THAT CHRISTIANITY WAS NO LONGER GOING TO BE A PART OF THEIR LIVES ALWAYS STATED SOME VERSION OF AT LEAST ONE OF THESE THREE THINGS. FOR MANY. ALL THREE.

- 1. THEY LOST FAITH THAT THE GOSPEL WAS TRUE.
- 2. THEY HATED SOMEONE IN THE CHURCH, OR IN THEIR FAMILY, OR IN THEIR LIFE, OFTEN SOMEONE NOT EVEN AFFILIATED WITH THE CHURCH, SEVERAL TIMES SOMEONE THAT WASN'T EVEN ALIVE ANYMORE.
- 3. THEY COULD NOT FORGIVE SOMEONE FOR SOMETHING.

THE BIBLICAL RESPONSE.

1. THE PERSON WHO LOSES FAITH IN THE TRUTHS OF THE GOSPEL, IN MY EXPERIENCE, EVERY TIME, DO NOT STUDY, OR READ THE BIBLE. IT IS FOR THIS REASON FOR THE LAST FORTY PLUS YEARS, THAT I STUDY THE BIBLE OUT LOUD. I READ THE BIBLE OUT LOUD. WHEN YOU EMPLOY THIS METHOD OF STUDY YOU GET THREE TIMES THE POWER. YOU ARE READING THE WORD, YOU ARE PROCLAIMING THE WORD, AND YOU ARE HEARING THE WORD.

"FAITH COMETH BY HEARING, AND HEARING BY THE WORD OF GOD." ROMANS 10:17

IF YOU PERSEVERE IN THIS PRACTICE, YOU WILL NEVER LOOSE FAITH. PERIOD.

- 2. HATE. HATE KILLS. IT DOESN'T EVEN HAVE TO BE A PERSON SOMETIMES. THE BIBLE IS CLEAR; WE ARE CALLED TO LOVE. 1 JOHN 4:20. "IF ANYONE SAYS HE LOVES GOD, BUT HATES HIS BROTHER. HE IS A LIAR..."
- 3. FORGIVENESS. JESUS SAID, "IF YOU DON'T FORGIVE, YOUR FATHER IN HEAVEN WON'T FORGIVE YOU". MARK 11:26. WHOEVER DID WHATEVER, IT'S NOT WORTH YOUR SOUL.
