First let's look at the current versions of Soteriology, or as defined by Websters dictionary, the study of salvation, specifically as dealing with Jesus Christ. Those that incorporate pieces of my view I have noted with a blue Asterix. *

Classical Soteriology: Focuses on Salvation by grace through faith in Christ. *

Pelagianism: Argues that human can achieve salvation through works without

grace.

Augustinianism: Asserts that original sin affects all humans, necessitating divine

grace for salvation. *

Calvinism: Emphasizes predestination, where God has already chosen who

will be saved, and we are irrelevant in our salvation. *

Arminianism: Proposes that although God is sovereign, we have free will, and

may choose to accept God's free gift of salvation or not. *

Universalism: This view purports that everyone will ultimately be saved,

regardless of our earthly choices in this life.

Liberation Theology: Connects salvation with social justice, advocating for the

oppressed and marginalized.

Process Theology: Views salvation as a process of becoming saved rather than a

one-time experience.

Mystical Soteriology: This position focuses on an experience with "the divine" rather

than a list of dos and don'ts.

Comparative Soteriology: Seeks to combine seeming truths across all religions to find

common ground.

Ransom Theory: An early church father soteriological theory that Jesus' death

was a ransom paid to Satan by Jesus for our souls.

Moral Influence Theory: That Jesus sacrifice would inspire us to lives of sacrifice and

service to the poor and needy. This theory has morphed into

Liberation Theology.

Penal Substitution Theory: That Jesus sacrifice paid the price for our sin, allowing God to be

just and merciful. *

Scapegoat Theory: Jesus is the scapegoat in a dualist messianic theory, or a single

scapegoat, from the Old Testament scapegoat offering.

My View on the subject:

- 1. I believe it is God's *will* that everybody be saved. We are saved when our name is written in the Lamb's Book of Life.



grafted in among the others and now share in the nourishing root of the olive tree, ¹⁸ do not be arrogant toward the branches. If you are, remember it is not you who support the root, but the root that supports you. ¹⁹ Then you will say, "Branches were broken off so that I might be grafted in." ²⁰ That is true. They were broken off because of their unbelief, but you stand fast through faith. So do not become proud, but fear. ²¹ For if God did not spare the natural branches, neither will he spare you. ²² Note then the kindness and the severity of God: severity toward those who have fallen, but God's kindness to you, provided you continue in his kindness. Otherwise you too will be cut off. ²³ And even they, if they do not continue in their unbelief, will be grafted in, for God has the power to graft them in again. ²⁴ For if you were cut from what is by nature a wild olive tree, and grafted, contrary to nature, into a cultivated olive tree, how much more will these, the natural branches, be grafted back into their own olive tree.
