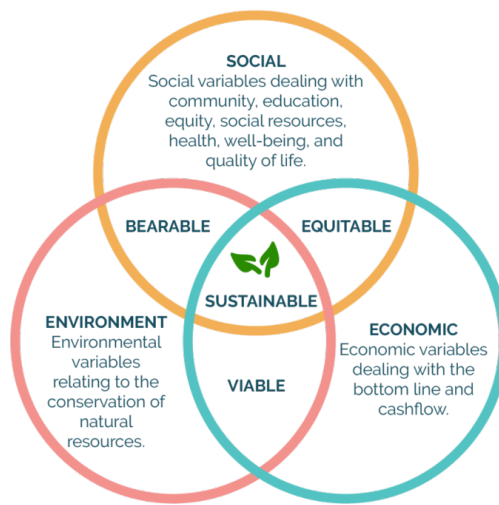


Figure 3: Types of Ecotourism

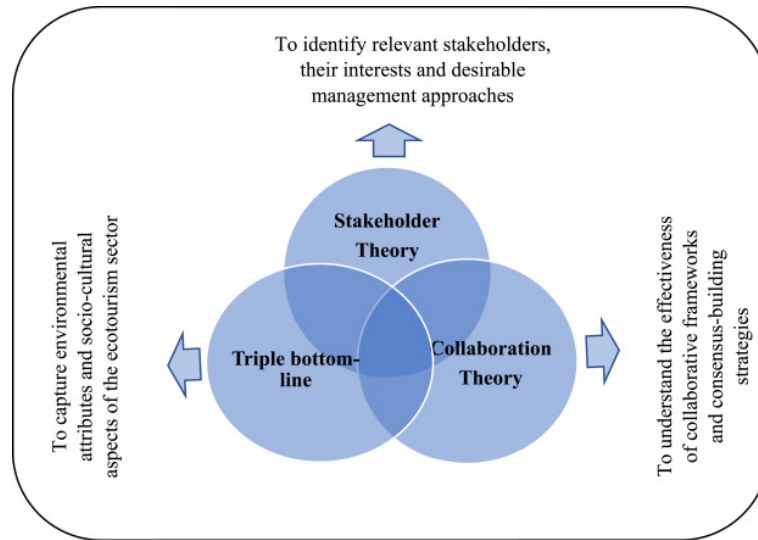


Figure 4: Stakeholder collaboration as a major factor for sustainable ecotourism development in developing countries

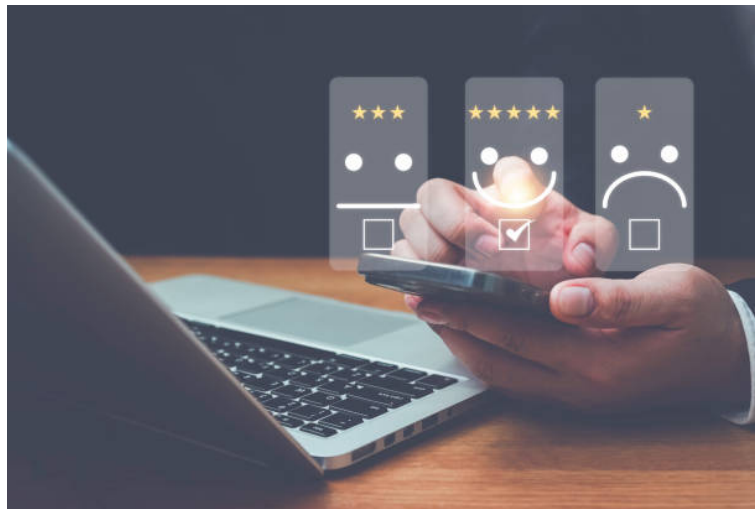


Figure 17: Guest and User Feedback
