Have pages to write down prayer requests, but be diligent to mark ANSWERED PRAYERS. By Praying Scripture back to GOD, you are assured of Powerful Prayers!!!

BE humble. Glorify God in your prayers. Have Faith that GOD will answer. Finally: BE ready for spiritual warfare and BE ready to see GOD work miracles.

You may notice that I capitalized the word BE in the above paragraph. I have learned in over 64 years of life, and 48+ years as a Believer, that it is better to Obey than to Sacrifice. In other words, BECOME AND BE a true Christian Believer & Follower. BE an imitator of Jesus Christ in everything you do and say. Learn to BE before you strive to "DO." The Character of the Christian Life is what GOD is looking for in a Believer. GOD looks at the heart of men and women. The Bible is full of examples of imperfect Believers of GOD, and we need to forgive ourselves of failures and sins. BUT the real question is "ARE YOU STRIVING TO "BE" A FAITHFUL BELIEVER WITH AN OPEN HEART, MIND, WILL, AND EMOTIONS UNTO THE LORD GOD?"

"DOING" is good. "BEING" is excellent.

The Power of GOD in your life is when you are striving, disciplining yourself, and training yourself to "BE" found Faithful before the Throne of GOD.

3. "Hallowed be THY NAME" - HaShem!

Isaiah 6:1-5 "In the year of King Uzziah's death, I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, lofty and exalted, with the train of His robe filling the temple. Seraphim stood above Him, each having six wings; with two he covered his face, and with two he flew. And one called out to another and said, 'Holy, Holy, is the LORD of hosts, the whole earth is full of His glory.' And the foundations of the thresholds trembled at the voice of him who called out, while the temple was filling with smoke. Then I said, 'Woe is me, for I am ruined! Because I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips; For my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts.'"

Revelation 15:4 says, "Who shall not fear Thee, O Lord, and glorify Thy name? for Thou art holy."

THE NAMES OF GOD THE FATHER

1. HaShem – THE NAME often designated to YHWH GOD, meaning THE HOLY NAME OF

GOD. This is a significant Name. You need to understand the emphasis on "THE." Ha (THE) Shem (Name). THE NAME (HaShem) represents the ALL POWERFUL AND HOLY GOD.

- 2. Elohim: The power and might of God.
- 3. El Elyon: The strongest Strong One.
- 4. El Roi: The Strong One who sees.
- 5. El Shaddi: The Breasted One.
- 6. El Olam: The Everlasting God.
- 7. Adonai: Master, Lord.
- 8. Jehovah: The Self-existent One.
- 9. Jehovah Jireh: The Lord will provide.
- 10. Jehovah Nissi: The Lord my Banner.
- 11. Jehovah Shalom: The Lord is Peace.
- 12. Jehovah Sabaoth: The Lord of Hosts.
- 13. Jehovah Maccadeschcem: The Lord my Sanctifier.
- 14. Jehovah Rohi (Raah): The Lord my Shepherd.
- 15. Jehovah Tsidkenu: The Lord my Righteousness.

4. "Let thy kingdom come"

Jesus' prayer here was concerned with the entrance of the Kingdom of God into the world, which is salvation by faith in Christ. This should be our prayer also today, meaning that we would like to see all come to repentance and faith in Jesus Christ the Lord. When praying this prayer, we are also asking for the "End Times," in other words that Christ will appear at His Second Coming and install His earthly kingdom for 1000 years, and finally establish His final Kingdom with putting away everything associated with evil, sin, and rebellion – to establish The New Heaven and New Earth that will be filled with Those Faithful Believers who made the choice(s) to follow and live for GOD through faith in the SAVIOR AND MESSIAH YESHUA Ha-MESSIAH (JESUS THE CHRIST).

5. "Let thy will be done on earth as it is done in heaven"

We yearn for the time when GOD's WILL will not be challenged by evil. This is an expectant prayer for "the new heaven and the new earth" in Revelation 21:1, when God's Will will be universally done throughout the earth without any resistance by Sin's advocates. Jesus will be seated as King in the new Jerusalem, King over all creation. As God intended in Genesis to originate at creation a humanity which would glorify God, He finishes with intensified glory after Revelation. Jesus gave this to his disciples with the hope that they, and us also, would pray for the finished creation which

comes after the finish of the book of Revelation.

6. "Give me this day my daily bread"

This is a prayer asking God to supply all your material needs, presently and for the future. God will bless you today with the omniscience of the future, so that you will have what you need when you need it. God's desire for your finances and spending is for you to tithe, give to the poor, homeless, widows, help others, provide for your family, and store up for the future. God does not intend for the hoarding of money, but rather, thrifty management of finances as a custodian of God's possession - wealth. God owns everything. It is He who gives wealth, limits wealth, and removes it. Your management of what God brings through your hands determines what He will trust you with in the future. This is not a prayer of asking amiss for great prominence and riches, but one of asking for plenty enough to supply the needs around you, including your own. Jesus gave this prayer to His disciples. It was His intention that people acknowledge their dependence upon God for every penny and dollar that comes through their hands each week.

A close friend and professor at Liberty University back in the 1980's, Dr. Sumner Wemp gives his testimony that he and his wife began praying this prayer every day after twenty years of marriage plagued with loans, and their struggle to keep debts paid. His experience was that God honored His given prayer to us and began bringing them out of debt. Soon they were financially out of all debt, excluding their house, and began storing up money so that they paid cash for everything in the future: cars, vacations, everything! They also were faithful custodians of God's finances. They gave liberally thousands of dollars each year into missions, including their own selves going to the fields to share the Gospel of the LORD and SAVIOR JESUS CHRIST.

James 1:17 "Every good thing bestowed and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with Whom there is no variation, or shifting shadow." (NASV)

Luke 16:11 "If therefore you have not been faithful in the use of worldly wealth, who will entrust the true riches to you?"

God Desires people to be diligent: In other words – Work! Do something!

Deuteronomy 8:18 "But you shall remember the LORD your God, for it is He who is giving you power to make wealth."

Proverbs 6:6-8 "Go to the ant, thou sluggard; consider her ways, and be wise: which having no guide, overseer, or ruler, provideth her meat in the summer, and gathereth her food in the harvest." (KJV)

Proverbs 10:3-5 "The Lord will not suffer the soul of the righteous to famish: but He casteth away the substance of the wicked. He becometh poor that dealeth with a slack hand: but the hand of the diligent maketh rich. He that gathereth in summer is a wise son: but he that sleepeth in harvest is a son that causeth shame." (KJV)

Proverbs 12:11 "He that tilleth his land shall be satisfied with bread: but he that followeth vain

persons is void of understanding." (KJV)

God desires us with His finances to help those who need help:

Proverbs 21:13 "Whosoever stoppeth his ears at the cry of the poor, he also shall cry himself, but shall not be heard." (KJV)

Proverbs 22:9 "He that hath a bountiful eye shall be blessed; for he giveth of his bread to the poor." (KJV)

God desires us to be content with what He supplys us, not envying for great worldly possessions: Proverbs 11:28 "He that trusteth in his riches shall fall: but the righteous shall flourish as a branch. (KJV)

Proverbs 13:7 "There is one who pretends to be rich, but has nothing; another pretends to be poor, but has great wealth." (NASV)

Proverbs 15:16 "Better is little with the fear of the Lord than great treasure and trouble therewith." (KJV)

Proverbs 27:20 "Hell and destruction are never full; so the eyes of man are never satisfied." (KJV)

Proverbs 30:7-9 "Two things I asked of Thee, do not refuse me before I die: Keep deception and lies far from me, give me neither poverty nor riches; feed me with the food that is my portion, lest I be full and deny Thee and say, 'Who is the Lord?' Or lest I be in want and steal, and profane the name of my God." (KJV)

1 Timothy 3:2-3 "An overseer (Greek= Presbuteros), then, must be above reproach... free from the love of money."

1 Timothy 6:6-19 "But godliness actually is a means of great fain, when accompanied by contentment. For we have brought nothing into the world, so we cannot take anything out of it either. And if we have food and covering, with these we shall be content. But those who want to get rich fall into temptation and a snare and many foolish and harmful desires which plunge men into ruin and destruction. For the love of money is a root of all sorts of evil, and some by longing for it have wandered away from the faith, and pierced themselves with many a pang. But flee from these things, you man of God; and pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, perseverance and gentleness. Fight the good fight of faith; take hold of the eternal life to which you were called, and you made the good confession in the presence of many witnesses. I charge you in the presence of God, who gives life to all things, and of Christ Jesus, who testified the good confession before Pontious Pilate, that you keep the commandment without stain or reproach until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ, which He will bring about at the proper time - He who is the blessed and only Sovereign, the King of kings, and Lord of lords; Who alone possesses immortality and dwells in unapproachable light; Whom no man has seen or can see. To Him be honor and eternal dominion! Amen. Instruct those who are rich in this present world not to be conceited or to fix their hope on the uncertainty of riches, but on God, Who richly supplies us with all things to enjoy. Instruct them to do good, to be rich in good works, to be generous and ready to share, storing up for themselves the treasure of a good foundation for the future, so that they may take hold of that which is life indeed." (NASV)

Ecclesiastes 5:10-20 "He who loves money will not be satisfied with money, nor he who loves abundance with its income. This too is vanity. When good things increase, those who consume them increase. So what is the advantage to their owners except to look on? The sleep of the working man is pleasant, whether he eats little or much. But the full stomach of the rich man does not allow him to sleep. There is a grievous evil which I have seen under the sun: riches being hoarded by their owner to his hurt. When those riches were lost through a bad investment and he had fathered a son, then there was nothing to support him. As he had come naked from his mother's womb, so will he return as he came. He will take nothing from the fruit of his labor that he can carry in his hand. And this also is a grievous evil - exactly as a man is born, thus will he die. So, what is the advantage to him who toils for the wind? Throughout his life he also eats in darkness with great vexation, sickness and anger. Here is what I have seen to be good and fitting: to eat, to drink and enjoy oneself in all one's labor in which he toils under the sun during the few years of his life which God has given him; for this is his reward. Furthermore, as for every man to whom God has given riches and wealth, He has also empowered him to eat from them and to receive his reward and rejoice in his labor: this is the gift of God. For he will not often consider the years of his life, because God keeps him occupied with the gladness of his heart." (NASV)

Every Christian is expected to manage his assets for to give financial tithes and offerings:

1 Corinthians 16:1-2 "Now concerning the collection **for** the saints, as I directed the churches of Galatia, so do you also. On the first day of every week let each one of you **put aside and save**, as he may prosper..." (NASV)

Malachi 3:8-11 "Will a man rob God? Yet you are robbing Me! But you say, 'How have we robbed Thee?' In tithes and offerings. You are cursed with a curse, for you are robbing Me, the whole nation of you! Bring the whole tithes into the storehouse, so that there may be food in My house, and test Me now in this, 'says the Lord of hosts, 'if I will not open for you the windows of heaven, and pour out for you a blessing until it overflows. Then I will rebuke the devourer for you, so that it may not destroy the fruits of the ground; nor will your vine in the field cast its grapes, says the Lord of hosts.' " (NASV)

Matthew 5:23-24 "If therefore you are presenting your offering at the altar, and there remember that your brother has something against you, leave your offering there before the altar, and go your way; first be reconciled to your brother, and then come and present your offering." (NASV)

Leviticus 30:30 "Thus all the tithe of the land, of the seed of the land or of the fruit of the tree, is the Lord's; it is holy to the Lord." (NASV)

2 Corinthians 9:5- "So I thought it necessary to urge the brethren that they would go on ahead to you and arrange beforehand your previously promised bountiful gift, that the same might be ready as a bountiful gift, and not affected by covetousness. Now this I say, he who sows sparingly shall also reap sparingly; and he who sows bountifully shall also reap bountifully. Let each one do just as he has purposed in his heart; not grudgingly or under compulsion; for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to make all grace abound to you, that always having all sufficiency in everything, you may have an abundance for every good deed; as it is written, 'He scattered abroad, He gave to the poor, His righteousness abides forever.' Now He who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food, will supply and multiply your seed for sowing and increase the harvest of your righteousness; you will be enriched in everything for all liberality, which through us is producing thanksgiving to God. For the ministry of this service is not only fully supplying the needs of the saints, but is also overflowing through many thanksgivings to God." (NASV)

7. "Forgive me for my sins, as I am forgiving others at the same time for their sins against me"

Mark 11:25 "And whenever you stand praying, forgive, if you have anything against anyone; so that your Father also who is in heaven may forgive you your transgressions. 26 "But if you do not forgive, neither will your Father who is in heaven forgive your transgressions."

God desires His people to have an attitude of forgiveness in our relationship experiences in the same way that He maintains an open door of forgiveness to us. His mercy and grace is patient, and He desires us to emulate this also. We should not expect forgiveness from God for our sins while consciously holding grudges, hatred, or unforgiveness toward someone else that has wronged us. It is important to note also that God promises forgiveness to those who ask for it, and any accusal from that point on is not of God, but by the Sin nature and the devil, who constantly accuses the brethren. 1 John 1:9 is the key to confession. Confess your sin, make reconciliation with those offended (if you have wronged someone else), and then trust in the validity of God's Word by having assurance of your forgiveness from God.

1 John 1:9 "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."

Proverbs 28:13 "He that covereth his sins shall not prosper: but whosoever confesseth and forsaketh them shall have mercy." (KJV)

Psalm 32:1-6 "How blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered! How blessed is the man to whom the Lord does not impute iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no deceit! When I kept silent about my sin, my body wasted away through my groaning all day long. For day and night Thy hand was heavy upon me; my vitality was drained away as with the fever heat of summer. [Selah] I acknowledged my sin to Thee, and my iniquity I did not hide; I said, 'I will confess my transgressions to the Lord'; and Thou didst forgive the guilt of my sin. [Selah] Therefore, let everyone who is godly pray to Thee in a time when Thou mayest be found." (NASV)

Psalm 139 23-24 "Search me, O God, and know my heart; try me and know my anxious thoughts; and see if there be any hurtful way in me, and lead me in the everlasting way." (NASV)

Proverbs 20:27 "The spirit of man is the lamp of the LORD, searching all the innermost parts of his being." (NASV)

Proverbs 5:21 "For the ways of a man are before the eyes of the LORD, and He watches all his paths." (NASV)

Proverbs 20:9 "Who can say, I have made my heart clean, I am pure from my sin?" (KJV)

THE TEN COMMANDMENTS: DEUTERONOMY 5:6-21

When I was young, someone said that the 10 Commandments are not commandments of "Prohibition," but of "Protection." In other words, GOD is not restricting us from having a good life, wanting us to live a boring life, but the opposite. By obeying the 10 Commandments, GOD is showing us how to have a life without troubles, without destructive sins and habits, without hurting others, and without false religion. When you learn the true meaning of the 10 Commandments, you will know the foundation of all Scripture and how to live a fun, fruitful, peaceful, recreational and carefree, honest, and loving life. But you must learn the meanings of the Hebrew words and how to apply them. You must learn how to apply these 10 Commandments in daily life, and what they are not saying being misinterpreted. (such as: Thou Shalt Not Murder is not saying that you should be a total passivist and deny your responsibility and right to self defense).

- 2. "You shall not make for yourself an idol, or any likeness of what is in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the water under the earth."
- 3. "You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain, for the LORD will not leave him

unpunished who takes His name in vain." (vain means: nothingness, empty, worthless). THE NAME is the Name HA-SHEM. This is a sacred and Holy NAME. The NAME represents the names of GOD. Remember that the Name "LORD" is the NAME above all names. Do not use the NAMES OF GOD in cursing, or even ridiculous ways. Many people respond in laughter saying "Oh Lord!" Don't use the name of the LORD in vain, slanderous ways.

- 4. "Observe the sabbath day to keep it holy." The Sabbath is a day set aside by GOD for YOU to experience several things: Worship, Study of the Scripture, Rest, Breathe fresh air, and Fellowship with other Believers, family and friends. This is GOOD for YOU. Observe the Sabbath. This is a commandment of Protection to keep your mind clear and sound, and keep you from "burning out."
- 5. "Honor your father and mother." Young people need to understand that while their parents are not perfect, they have lots to offer. Parents deserve honor. When they do not deserve honor, it is RIGHTEOUS to give them honor is whatever way you can list out. Everyone has something honorable. Many times drunks are honest, abusive parents provide good clean homes to live in, or even defeated parents are still striving to survive the family. Honoring your parents is a "crown of righteousness" for YOU. Most times you need to forgive your parents for their short-comings, which removes the hate and hurt from our soul. Deal with this! Get Christian counseling if needed! By releasing your hurts, YOU will be set FREE!
- 6. "You shall not murder." Murder is hate and premeditated killing of another person. Murder is not self defense in the moment of defending one-self from injury and attack.
- 7. "You shall not commit adultery." (adultery means marital infidelity of Holy Marriage between a Man and a Woman. It also means spiritual adultery such as worshipping Evil elohims/ "gods" or angels).
- 8. "You shall not steal." What is not yours truthfully and honestly don't take it! The best form of success is not what you have, but what you have earned truthfully. Stealing is insulting GOD in that GOD is not providing your needs and wants??? Live within your means and learn how to manage your finances and assets which will prepare you to be a Steward of Greater Things. GOD cannot bless YOU until you learn how to Manage the Riches of GOD's provision.
- 9. "You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor." Don't gossip about others. Let you speech be "Yes" and "No." Do not stretch the truth and don't criticize other people. If you don't have something good to say about someone else just don't say it!
- 10. "You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, and you shall not desire your neighbor's house, his field or his male servant or his female servant, his ox or his donkey or anything that belongs to your neighbor." We all deal with some form of Lust or sinful Desire. I learned to look at other people's things by appreciating what I did have. Coveting is a destructive thing in the mind and soul. I also learned early in life that many times what I did not have was a blessing. The longer you live the more you witness that GOD is "NOT WITHHOLDING ANY GOOD THING FROM YOU." Other marriages, their possessions, etc, doesn't mean that they are happy. Learn

to live on less – less things – a few great friends – even without a girlfriend/boyfriend, spouse, and less activities to cloud up your mind and soul.

"THE TEN COMMANDMENTS OF LOVE"

- 1. Thou shalt put thy spouse before thy mother, thy father, thy son and daughter, thy vocation, thy hobby, yea, even before thine own pleasure -- for thy mate is thy lifelong companion. Husband, love your wife as much a Christ loves His children. Wife, submit to your husband as the spiritual and vocational leader in your family, remembering that he is not perfect, but desiring the best for you and your family.
- 2. Abuse not thy body with excessive food, tobacco, alchoholic drinks, or any foreign substance that goeth into thy arm or up thy nose.
- 3. Do not forget that cleanliness is a virtue.
- 4. Permit neither thy business nor thy hobby to make thee a stranger to thy children, for the most precious gift a parent can give children is time.
- 5. Make not a beggar of thy mate. Willingly share worldly goods and live within your means.
- 6. Forget not to say, "I love you." For even though thy love may be constant, thy mate doth yearn to hear those cherished words.
- 7. Remember that the approval of thy mate is worth far more than the adoring glances of a million strangers, so cleave to thy mate, and forsake all others.
- 8. Keep thy home in good repair, for out of it cometh the joys of old age (not to mention its resale value).
- 9. Forgive with grace, for who among us does not need to be forgiven?
- 10. Honor the Lord thy God all the days of thy life, and thy children will grow up and bless you.

8. "And do not lead me into temptation, but deliver me from evil"

This is a prayer of dependance upon God concerning His providential soverienty over our life each day. We are to live by faith in His total care over us and His omnipotent paramount control. We are to live as Job and not scrutenize our constant circumstances with our limited mortal intellect, but live with faith and glorify God in all our behaviors. We must also carry the "shield of faith" so as to repress all of the supernatural attacks of satan and his demons. (Ephesians 6:16)

The whole armor of God

Eph 6:10-18 "Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. Put on the whole armor of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. Wherefore take unto you the whole armor of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God: Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints."

Luke 22:40 "Pray that you may not enter into temptation." (NASV)

1 Cor 10:13 "There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it."

Him that overcometh will I make a pillar in the temple of my God, and he shall go no more out: and I will write upon him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God, which is new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: and I will write upon him my new name. He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches."

John 16:1-8 "These things have I spoken unto you, that ye should not be offended. They shall put you out of the synagogues: yea, the time cometh, that whosoever killeth you will think that he doeth God service. And these things will they do unto you, because they have not known the Father, nor me. But these things have I told you, that when the time shall come, ye may remember that I told you of them. And these things I said not unto you at the beginning, because I was with you. But now I go my way to him that sent me; and none of you asketh me, Whither goest thou? But because I have said these things unto you, sorrow hath filled your heart. Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you. And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:" (This is the primary work of the Holy Spirit; Pray according to these functions as you call upon the Holy Spirit to answer your prayers).

Do not grant, O LORD, the desires of the wicked; do not promote his evil device, lest they be exalted. [Selah]" (NASV)

accorded him." (NASV) (praise tests a man; it separates impure from pure)

Put a hedge of divine protection around me according to your mercy and my righteousness. Job 1:10 "Hast Thou not made a hedge about him and his house and all that he has, on every side? Thou hast blessed the work of his hands, and his possessions have increased in the land.

Guard, protect, and minister to me with your heavenly angels.

Hebrews 1:14 Are they not all ministering spirits, sent out to render service for the sake of those who will inherit salvation?

1 Chronicles 4:10 Now Jabez called on the God of Israel, saying, "Oh that Thou wouldst bless me indeed, and enlarge my border, and that Thy hand might be with me, and that Thou wouldst keep me from harm, that it may not pain me!" And God granted him what he requested. God blessed Jabez. This needs to be a prayer of all Believers.

9. "For Thine, Father, Is The Kingdom, The Power, And The Glory, Forever. Amen."

This acknowledges God's possession of all the control of His Kingdom, His sustaining Omnipotence over its eternal existence, and worthy of all the glorification in His victory for all eternity.

Matthew 25:31 "When the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the angels with Him, then He will sit on His glorious throne." (NASV)

Though youths grow weary and tired, and vigorous young men stumble badly, yet those who wait for the LORD will gain new strength; they will mount up with wings like eagles, they will run and not get tired, they will walk and not become weary." (NASV)

FORMULA FOR EMPOWERED SERVICE

- 1. Be madly in love with Jesus, thankful to Him for His terrible death in your place.
- 2. Abandon yourself from all selfishness, to the will and plan of God: not caring that others may ridicule you for being so zealous for Jesus.
- 3. Be persistently agonizing in prayer with God: in everything by prayer and supplications, lifting up holy hands, a clean heart, a clean tongue, and a single mind.
- 4. Ask for the filling of the Holy Spirit, and by faith believe God's promise to give Him to those who hunger and thirst after righteousness.

John 15:10-11 "If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love; just as I have kept My Father's commandments, and abide in His love. These things I have spoken to you, that My joy may be in you, and that your joy may be made full."

Acts 1:7-8 "He said to them, 'It is not for you to know the times or epochs which the Father has fixed by His own authority; but you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth."
