Participation Rules

The Hugo PRCA Rodeo committee is dedicated to keeping our youth involved in the traditional skills of horsemanship, horse mastership, and sportsmanship. The Junior Drill Team is an opportunity for young riders to advance their skill in an enjoyable atmosphere with other young equine enthusiast. Hugo PRCA Rodeo committee's first responsibility is to create a safe environment for our young riders and involved parents. Below is a list of rules that must be followed by parents, riders, and family members involved and associated with the Hugo PRCA Rodeo Junior Drill Team.

- 1. The coaches shall be in complete charge at all practices and performances. Coaches have the authority to dismiss anyone displaying improper conduct or anyone not willing to abide by the rules.
- 2. The objective of the Junior Drill Team is to promote better horsemanship, leadership and sportsmanship skills.
- 3. Members must attend at least 75% of all practices from March through June to be eligible to perform at the annual Hugo PRCA Rodeo.
- 4. All team members are required to wear long pants and riding boots for all practices and performances.
- 5. Horses must be well mannered (no kicking, biting, etc.)
- 6. Horses must be healthy in appearance and not show signs of illness or lameness.
- 7. Negative Coggins within 12 months are required on any horse brought to a Junior Drill Team function. A copy of the Coggins must be given to the Drill Team Coaches at the First of Practice.
- 8. A horse that has never been to a practice cannot be used at a performance.
- 9. No stallions are allowed.
- 10. During practice, only Junior drill team members, Coaches, and individuals invited by coaches into the arena to assist in Junior drill team practice will be allowed into arena.
- 11. Parent/guardian must bring, attend, and take home Junior Drill Team member and horse. If parent/guardian cannot attend or is sending Junior Drill Team member and horse with another person; Coaches must have verbal/written consent from parent/guardian.
- 12. Junior Drill Team Rules and Release Forms must be signed by parent/guardian before beginning of first practice.
- 13. It is the responsibility of the parent to be sure all tack and equipment is in proper working order, the horse is saddled and bridled correctly, and that the cinch is correctly tightened.
- 14. During performances team riders and parents must wear long sleeve button up shirts.
