

Tomato varieties Grass Roots plans for 2021.

Early

Early Girl – 57 days. Indeterminate, red, 4-6oz. fruit. Firm texture, heavy yields. Hybrid.

New Girl – 62 days, red, indeterminate. 4-6 oz., better taste than Early Girl

Park's Season Starter – 60 days, determinate, red, 6 oz. fruit, dense, yet mild. Hybrid

Mid-Season

Celebrity – 70 days, determinate, red. Good for canning, 8 oz. fruit, crack resistant. Hybrid

Better Bush – 68 days, indeterminate, red. 10-oz. fruit. Firm, juicy, rich. Hybrid

Better Boy – 70 days, indeterminate, red. 10-oz. fruit, juicy. Hybrid

Jetstar – 70days, indeterminate, red. Low-acidity, 8 oz. fruit. Hybrid

Rutgers – 75 days, red, determinate. Good canner, heavy walls, 7oz. fruit,, disease resistant.

Chef's Choice Orange – 75days, indeterminate. Low-acid, high-yielding

Late

Beefsteak – 65 days?, red, indeterminate. 12-14 oz. fruits, for slicing, eating fresh.

Big Boy – 78 days, red, indeterminate. Superb flavor, 1-lb., crack-resistant fruit

Big Beef – 73 days, red, indeterminate. Adapts to any climate, 9-16 oz.fruit

Big Brandy – 78 days, pink, indeterminate. 12-15 oz., Brandywine hybrid

Mountain Merit – 75 days, red, determinate. Late Blight Resistant, 8-10 oz. slicer

Pink Berkeley Tie Dye – 75 days, pink stripe, indeterminate. Rich, smoky, juicy, 8-12 oz.

Big Yummy

Big Rainbow – 80-90 days, indeterminate. Spectacular, 2-lb. fruit, low-acid, red-gold striped.
Gretchen's favorite.

Yellow Large

Lemon Boy – 72 days, lemon yellow, indeterminate. 6-7oz. fruits, low-acid. Hybrid

Carolina Gold, 75 days, determinate. Golden yellow, low-acid, extra-large slicer

Roma – Paste Tomato

Roma – 75 days, red, determinate. Paste-type tomato. Heavy crops, few seeds

Amish Paste – 85 days, red, indeterminate. Paste tomato, 8-12 oz., thick flesh

San Marzano – 78 days, indeterminate. Large Old World favorite, from Parma, Italy.

Jersey Devil – 80 to 90 days. Red, 6" long, heavy producer

Grape

Juliet – 60 days, red, indeterminate. 1 oz., crack-resistant fruit

Yellow Pear – 70 days, indeterminate, Mild flavor, salad tomato.

Cherry Tomato

Sugary – 80 days, red, semi-determinate. 2-oz. oval fruit.

Sun Sugar – 62 days, yellow, indeterminate. Ultimate in sugar content, high-yielding, thin skin

Super Sweet 100 – 65 days, red, indeterminate. Long strands of super-sweet fruits, High Vit. C.

Chocolate Cherry – 70 days, wine-red fruits, indeterminate, rich flavor.

Sweet Pea (currant size) – 62 days, red, indeterminate. ¼ " fruit

Tumbling Tom Yellow, Red – 70 days, red or yellow, indeterminate. Long cascades of 1 oz. fruits

Patio Hybrid – 70 days, red, determinate. Cherry for containers, dwarf plant.

Peardrops-Hanging Basket – early/mid season, yellow, indeterminate. High acid

Sweet Million

Micro – Tom, early, for containers. 6 -9 inches tall. Red-orange

Sweet 'N Neat Scarlet Imp Tomato – 60 days, determinate. Red, compact patio or container .

Sweet, 1 inch red

Mountain Honey – 70 days, semi-determinate. Hybrid, disease-resistant. Good flavor.

Orange Hat – micro cherry tomato, grow in 6" pot! Golden-orange, prolific

Heirloom

Brandywine – 80 days, red-pink, indeterminate. 10-24 oz., legendary heirloom fruit

Big Rainbow – 85 days, orange w/red streaks, indeterminate. Firm, low-acid, flavorful

Cherokee Purple – 80-90 days, purple-brown skin, indeterminate. 8-12 oz. fruit

Black Krim – 69 days, deep red, indeterminate. Early, very tasty.

San Marzano – 95 days. Red, paste tomato, heirloom indeterminate.

Mr. Stripecy – 80 days, indeterminate. Red, pink striping, sweet, large slicer

Paul Robeson – 80-90 days. Brick-red, 6-12 oz. fruit with smokey, earthy taste. Ind.

Soldacki – 75 days. From Poland. Red, low-acid, intensely, sweet flavor. 1lb. fruit.

Opalka – 85 days. Long, pepper-shape, red. Ideal for sauces and canning.

Black Vernissage – Purple-red, 2-3oz. indeterminate. Sweet/tart, smokey

Artisan Tomato

Purple Bumblebee – 70 days, indeterminate. Green metallic stripes on red fruit. 1 – 3 oz. fruit.

Pink Bumble bee – 70 day, indeterminate. Pink cherry streaked with gold. Sweet, 1-3 oz. fruit

Sunrise Bumblebee – 70 day, indeterminate. Sweetest Artisan. Yellow and red streaks.
