Monday Golf League Guidelines

(Named after Charlie Warner as the founding member)

1: This is a fun league that provides economical golf, socializing, and sportsmanship in a Club environment.

2: The committee for the Walter Gretzky Retirees will serve as the committee for the Charlie Warner Monday Golf League.

For operational decision making, a quorum consist of a simple majority of the Walter Gretzky Retirees Committee including at least three (3) of the Executive members plus enough Committee members to establish the quorum (7 out of 14).

3: At the year-end closing banquet held for the Walter Gretzky Retirees Thursday league, the position of Secretary. Treasurer and Vice-president may be open for election each year.

At the WGR year-end closing banquet every two years, the outgoing Vice-president will automatically assume the office of President in the following year to assure continuity and consistency.

4: CW Monday League membership consists of being a fully paid-up member of the Walter Gretzky Golf Course or payment of weekly green fees plus payment of "League fees" as noted below; retired or semi-retired; 55 years of age or older; or by Executive exemption.

CW League Membership will be limited to 165 men.

Membership "League fees" for the CW Monday Retirees League is \$60.00 payable on or before the first day of league play.

A CW retiree's league membership card will be issued when Fees are paid.

5: No guests until June 15. Guests can play a maximum of three (3) weeks throughout the season if space available with no membership charge but are not eligible for any weekly hole contest prizes but could win a golf ball. (appropriate green fees must be paid)

6: Normal CW league play days are on Mondays with starts between 7:30 AM and 9:30 AM and 7:00AM to 9:00AM during summer. The pro shop reserves the appropriate number of tee times however on occasions due to other Club tournaments, play day may be Tuesdays, with a possible shotgun start. Normally a cross-over format will be used throughout the year. If you forget to sign up or must withdraw, call the pro-shop.

7: Games will be played as foursomes over eighteen holes. Players are required to sign up on the league web site (northridgeretirees.com) no later than the Friday at noon before the weekly draw. Players can make up their own foursomes if they wish and request early or late tee off times. Technical Director will do his best to accommodate all requests. The weekly foursomes and Tee off times will be posted the Saturday prior to game date on the league web site.

8: League membership includes:

- A golf ball is awarded to the top golfers for the game played each week. Approximately 25% of the golfers playing on any given league day will receive a golf ball. All ties will be honoured by staying as close as possible to the 25% ceiling.
- As well, a prize of \$20.00 will be awarded weekly for the winners of closest to the pin on holes, # 2, # 8, #11 and # 14.
- A weekly cash prize will be drawn with the winners name posted game day.
- Closing banquet including meal + additional prizes + potential rebate card.

9: Results each week are posted on the league web site, following league play.

10: Members must abide by Walter Gretzky Golf Club rules and all RCPGA rules, however, to help speed-up play the following local league rules will be applied:

- Winter rules are in effect for the entire league season.
- On the tee box, if the fairway (or green) is open, “**ready golf**” is acceptable however, eagles and birdies should be honoured.
- “Continuous putting” on the green is the norm. Putts of 2 feet or less are gimmies”
- If you are three over par and not yet holed out, pick up your ball, declare a triple bogie for score and move on.
- Instead of a mulligan on the first hole you have the option of taking your second shot from the 150 marker.
- Members may choose to play from the red tees. However once this option is selected the member must continue using the red tees.

11: Maximum handicap assigned will be thirty-three.

12: The CW Monday League schedule normally starts close to the last Monday of April, with the closing field day and banquet the last Monday in September.

13: Any man wishing to join the Walter Gretzky Retirees Thursday league should contact an Executive member. If necessary, a waiting list will be established by the Technical Director for future seasons.

- a) A waiting list will be limited to 25 players

- b) Golfers who have a medical issue and can not return for one (1) year to the Retiree's that they played in the previous year will be given a Medical Exemption and be allowed to sign up to go onto the top of the waiting list for the Retiree's the following year. They will be allowed to sign up to the waiting list for the Retiree's league or Retiree's leagues which they played in one (1) year previous
- c) Past members returning after only one (1) year's absence will go on the waiting list ahead of non-members on the waiting list. An absence of two (2) or more years from either Retiree's leagues will mean a loss of priority over non-members on the waiting list.
- d) Golfers who have been in one (1) Retiree's league may change to the other Retiree's league in the following year but will have to go on a waiting list for that season where they will have priority over non-members on the waiting list.
- e) Members who have been absent from the Retiree's league for one (1) season may join only the league that they were in previously and go on the waiting list for that league and have priority over non-members on the waiting list
- f) Golfers on the waiting list will move up only when the golfers ahead of them get accepted into the league. Registering early for the waiting list is crucial.

14: If a member during league play scores a hole-in-one, the Executive will make available up to \$100.00 to offset any bar costs. (Receipts will be required)

15: If a member is injured for any reason or has a medical emergency during league play, the injury must be reported immediately to the pro-shop staff and follow all Walter Gretzky Club guidelines/procedures.
