God the Father gave his one and only Son as a substitute for sinful human beings. He would die in their place, bearing their sins. But salvation from sin through the Son requires faith: Everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life. When you trust in Jesus alone as your personal sin bearer, divine judgement is removed, and eternal life is freely given.
