

## YOUR DOG'S SAFETY AND WELL-BEING IS IMPORTANT TO US. WE ARE FOLLOWING THE MOST UP-TO-DATE GUIDANCE FROM THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE IN OUR FACILITIES BY:

- Ensuring dogs entering the facility are healthy and do not present with symptoms such as coughing, sneezing, eye/nasal discharge or lethargy.
- Monitoring dogs in our care for symptoms of respiratory illness (including coughing, fever, nasal/eye discharge and lethargy).
- Engaging in a two-step cleaning and disinfecting process for tubs, tables and kennels.
- Not allowing dogs to co-mingle (unless from the same family)
- Asking our clients to pick up as soon as possible to limit their time with us and avoid excessive time in the kennels.

Please notify us if your dog has been boarded or is frequently in close contact with other dogs at the park, daycare, etc. Urban Dogg and its groomers cannot be held responsible in the unfortunate event your dog contracts a respiratory illness.
