This meeting should last no more than seven minutes.

This meeting should be directed by Packaging Lead or AP Lead Certified staff only.

- 2) Who are AP, PKG, LM, HA, and HU leads and who are thier backups?
  - 3) Who will be pulled to help PKG and AP?
    - 4) Who are the 100% Rollers?
    - 5) Announce the Daily Production Goal
  - 6) How many packages must be finished to hit that goal?
    - 7) How many grams are in each package?
- 8) What is the SKU and packaging for each? Set an example of each out on front table?
  - 9) Any Special info/annoucnements?

## WHY ARE WE DOING THIS?

We must ensure that 100% Rollers are rolling 100% of the time.

Production numbers are best when the rolling team is 100% focused on the single task of rolling.

## We must ensure that X% Rollers are rolling the highest % of the time possible.

Production numbers are best when the rolling team is 100% focused on the single task of rolling.

The PKG and AP Leads have a deep understanding of the flow of the line, and have been trained in the best methods to push production numbers. They alone will dictate when Rollers are pulled.

### An understanding of the scope of the full shift allows staff to perform with confidence.

Ensuring our staff understand the shift as a whole reduces the number of 'Shoulder Taps' on Leads and Setup. Ensuring our staff understand the shift as a whole reduces downtime.

Ensuring our staff understand the shift as a whole allows them to catch mistakes.
