### Marines in the Movies

### <u>Who Am I?</u>

He was born 18 October 1927 in Wise Virginia where his father was a coal mine surveyor. When the Depression took away that job father moved the family to Pontiac Michigan for a new job at the Buick assembly plant. His wife held down the fort at home where she also wrote poetry, gave readings and taught her two children to enjoy reading stories aloud. When his mother died (he was eight at the time) the overwhelming loss of her guidance turned to rage which this future Marine directed toward football and any other physical activity he could attack. After graduating from high school where he focused on baseball he joined the Marine on 16 June 1945. By the time he graduated Parris Island (Platoon 329) World War II had ended.

After P.I. he was sent to Marine Barracks, Washington DC. Among his duties was serving as part of the grave detail during military honors for veterans buried at Arlington National Cemetery. He had been greatly disappointed at missing combat but after seeing hundreds of burials and the devastated widows left behind he began to see war in the brutal light of reality.

He was discharged as a staff sergeant on 15 June 1949 receiving the WWII Victory Medal and the Good Conduct Medal. He used the GI Bill to attend the University of Missouri. At 21 he was already fighting a personal war with his inner rage and an excessive drinking habit. While at UM he studied drama and journalism and worked with a theater group. He played the lead in several university productions. This lead to teaching a literature course at Stephens College for Women in Columbia Missouri. He married one of his students (his first of 5 marriages) in 1951. In 1954 he moved with his second wife to New York where she worked in a as a secretary and he in a bank. He faced rejection after rejection trying out for acting jobs. Finally in 1957 He landed the lead role in Richard III. This was the start of a distinguished acting career.

Through his career he was nominated for several (winning one) Oscars, several Emmy awards, a National Critic's Choice award and numerous other awards to recognize his enormous talent. He and his various wives had 5 children including 2 actors. You might not recognize him as King Richard III or as Gen. Buck Turgidson (Dr. Stranglove – 1964) or any of the 93 other roles he played on television and movies but I am sure you would recognize him with his chrome helmet liner as General George S. Patton – yes, our Marine actor is none other than George C. Scott

### National Bylaws Article Six - Members, Section 645 - Life Members:.


