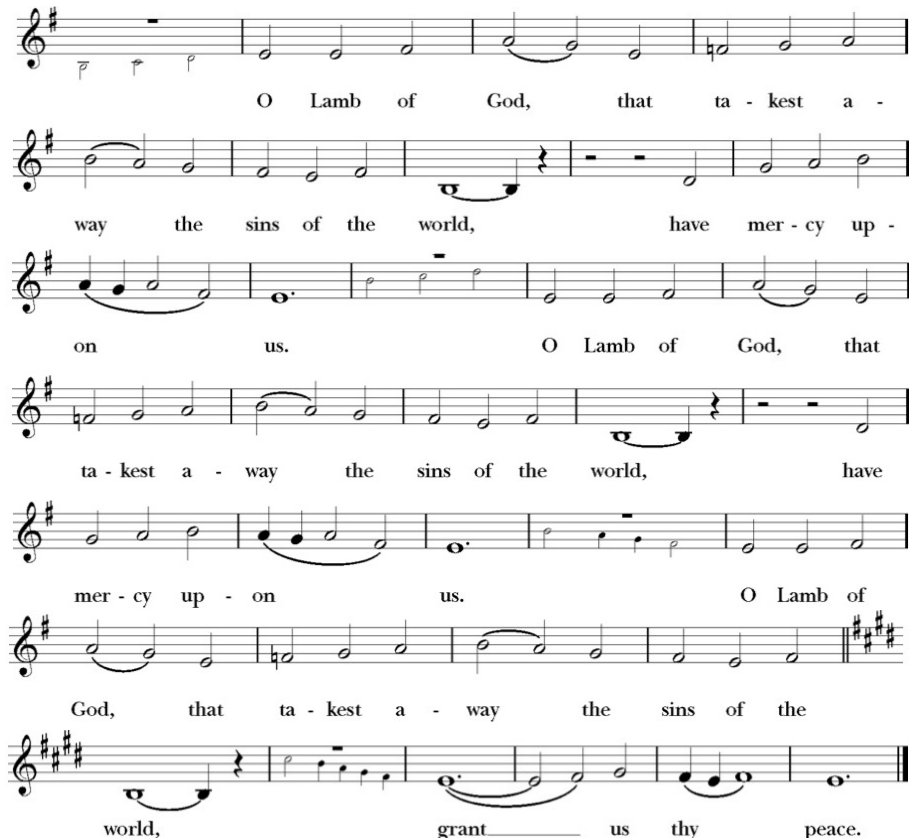




As the bells ring, all stand and remain standing through the Collect. Stand for Hymns, Sit or kneel for Prayers unless otherwise directed




