When I was growing up, All Soul's Day has always been a big event. In fact, it is considered a national holiday in the Philippines. Family members would meet up around their loved ones tomb by sunrise, bringing with them not just candles and flowers but also lots and lots of food, often the departed's favorites. After saying the prayers, we all dine, share stories and even sing our hearts out until dusk. It is like having a family reunion or a "tailgate party" in the cemeteries.

This tradition is something I really cherish for it reminds me of the Three Levels of the Church.
