I grew up in a rural area where I enjoyed planting trees. I love rearing farm animals too. However, I have to admit, I never learned how to plant or take care of flowers. They always seem to wither and eventually die under my watch.

Maybe not because I don't have a green thumb. I think I am just lazy to talk and sing to them like most people do. Or maybe I always forget to water them.
