Pastor's Notes

Someone once approached me and asked about today's Gospel because the message seemed to contradict some of our basic teachings. We all know that Jesus is the Prince of Peace. Yet, in the reading, it mentioned that He came not to establish peace but division. Particularly, division between family members, immediate family members.

To understand this Gospel, it is essential to dig deeper and look closely into the historical and cultural background of the people as well as the time the text was written.

During those days, it is normal for families to turn in their very own family members - fathers, mother, siblings, in laws, when they found out that he or she has done things which are against their laws or norms. They do not hesitate to disown an immediate relative. In fact, doing so is an honorable act.

Jesus reminds us that following Him is not easy. We will encounter situations wherein we have to choose between silencing our beliefs for peace or cause division for standing up for what we know is the truth. In His time, Jesus was not only mocked for speaking the truth. It even caused his death.

The same still holds true today. We as Christians will encounter situations where our faith will be tested that even our very own household will question our actions. We will have officemates, neighbors and friends who will make fun of us when we talk about our faith or when we post something religious in our Facebook page. Some will be criticized, judged or even shunned.

As troubling this may seem, may this passage serve as an encouragement when we are rejected for following Christ. May we continue to persevere in our belief, keeping the fire of faith alive and burning brightly each day.
