

#### **Pastor's Notes**

"Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid."

In today's Gospel, Jesus is telling us about His ascension to heaven. Though we, His disciples will no longer see Him physically, He assured us that we will not be alone in our life journey. He promised to send the Holy Spirit, the Advocate to teach us everything and to remind us of what He has told us.

His words and the gift of the Holy Spirit should be enough for us to fully experience peace here on earth. Yet, thousands of years later, in spite of our exponential growth in number, fully organized religious structure and huge freedom to practice our faith, many are still restless, confused and fearful daily.

In fact, in the recent National Health Statistics Report of the US CDC, in 2022, 1 in 5 adults (ages 18 and above) are experiencing symptoms of anxiety and depression. The highest were among the 18-29 years old. From 2019-2022 alone, there was a significant increase from 15.6% to 18.2% for anxiety and 18.5% to 21.4% for depression.

#### What has happened to us?

We are living in a time where communication is the fastest and easiest. We can practice our faith openly without fear of prosecution. We are even protected by our constitution! But somehow, our core values and basic beliefs seem to decline. We keep on failing to understand and trust what Jesus has been teaching us. We know but we choose not to live it.

As we begin the week, let us once again try to open our hearts to the presence of the Holy Spirit in our lives. More importantly, may we choose to strongly and tightly hold on to the words that Jesus said to us. If there is one thing consistent in this world, it is Him. His words are true then. It's true now and will remain true in the future.


