"...for God sees what's in the heart..."

Today's Gospel reminds me of the saying "shallow water is loud while deep waters are calm and quiet."

God looked kindly on the tax collector because of his humility in accepting his sinfulness and begging for God's mercy in his life. By acknowledging his emptiness, he was open to receive God's forgiveness and grace.

This is opposite to the prayer of the Pharisee. His self praise and outright proclamation of righteousness prevented him from receiving God's grace. By broadcasting that he lacked nothing, he is also saying that he doesn't need anything from God anymore.

How many times have we become like the Pharisee? How many times have we compared ourselves to others and told God that we are better Christians?

This week, I pray that we consciously be like the tax collector. May we humble ourselves in God's presence ask for his continued mercy in all that we do.



Earlier this week, I received a very heartwarming letter from a local resident. He was not a registered parishioner of St. Anne but has been a long time supporter. In his letter, he mentioned that he attached a donation in memory of his father.
