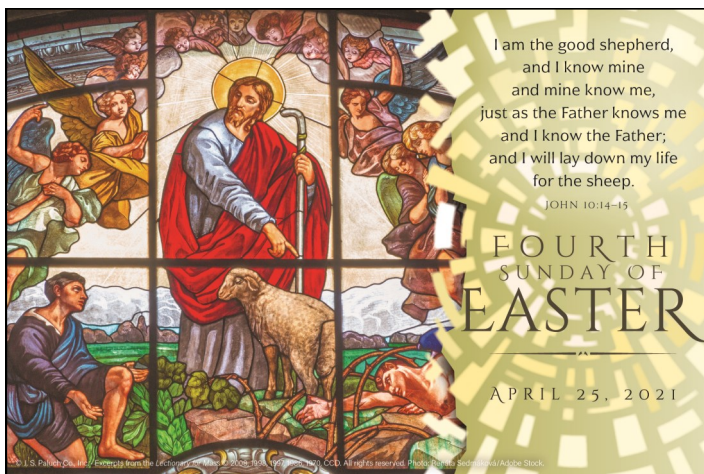
RELIGIOUS EDUCATION AND SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION

RESPONDING TO THE CALL
