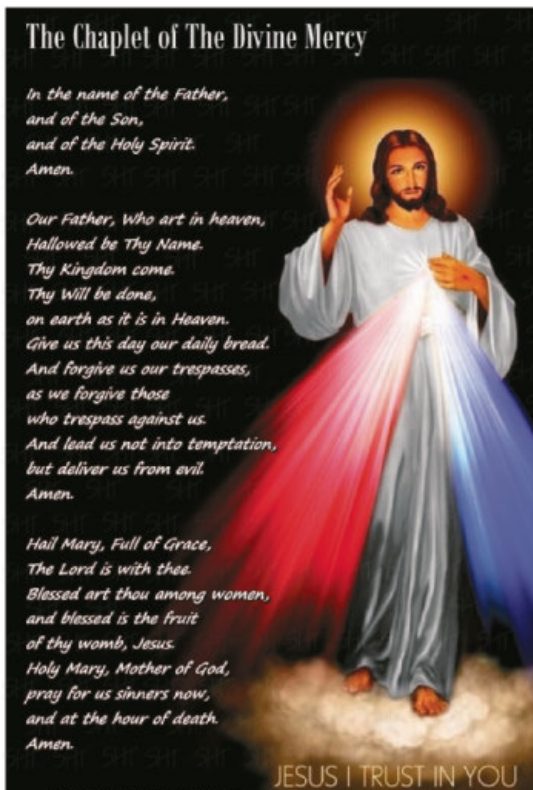
On April 18, Tuesday, we will resume our weekly Bible Study at 7pm in the Bethlehem Room.
