Statement from the Archdiocese of Newark concerning the reopening of Churches

A general dispensation from the Sunday obligation will remain until further notice.

The dispensation for the obligation to attend Mass will remain in effect. No one will be required to attend Mass when public celebrations resume. Hence, live stream Masses for parishioners at home will continue.

Attendance will be limited. We know restrictions will remain on holding large gatherings, so we are working with parishes to determine the best way to ensure safety. Communications will come from the parish so parishioners will know how many people can attend any given Mass.

It is likely that all parishioners may not be able to attend Mass regularly at first.

Social Distancing will be practiced. Expect that your parish will have pews/rows that are taped off, and that households, even of one individual, will be asked to keep six feet of separation from each other.

No one will be admitted without a mask. Parishioners should take their temperature before coming to Mass.

Anyone with any symptoms of sickness must stay home.

Liturgical changes will be in place. Similar to protocols established when churches were closing, extra precautions will be taken. Temporary adjustments will be made to how we celebrate Mass and receive Communion.

There still will be a risk for anyone who attends a public Mass. Even with best health practices and strict social distancing, anyone who enters a public space should recognize there is a risk of contracting the coronavirus. Improved cleaning will occur at our churches, but no one should expect that they will be any safer from germs than in other public spaces.

Aug. 2, 2020: 18th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Religious Education will take a temporary new form this Fall!

Since there is still uncertainty as to how the Elementary schools in our communities will function this coming Fall, we have decided to approach Religious Education in the following manner.

1. Only those students preparing for a Sacrament (First Communion & Confirmation) will have “in class” instruction. We will be using the Bethlehem Room which allows us to have ample “Safe distancing” for students. *First Communion* instruction will be on **Sundays**, starting on **October 4, at the usual time. (10:45 AM)**

Confirmation students will meet on Saturday mornings. (Registration for *Confirmation* and full details of the program will be available next week.)

2. We will provide materials for all other students so that parents may conduct **Religious Study at home**. We ask that parents register their students so that materials may be ordered. We will have a meeting for all parents in September to explain the programs.

3. **Religious Education will be “Free of Charge” this coming year.** All expenses for materials will be covered by the parish or generous donors.

This week, all families that had students in our program last year, will receive Registration materials in the mail.

Please fill them out and return them as soon as possible so that we may make adequate preparation.

Additional Registration Materials will be available at the Main entrance of the Church. You may also contact the Parish Office to request a registration form.

We will keep all informed if there are any changes.

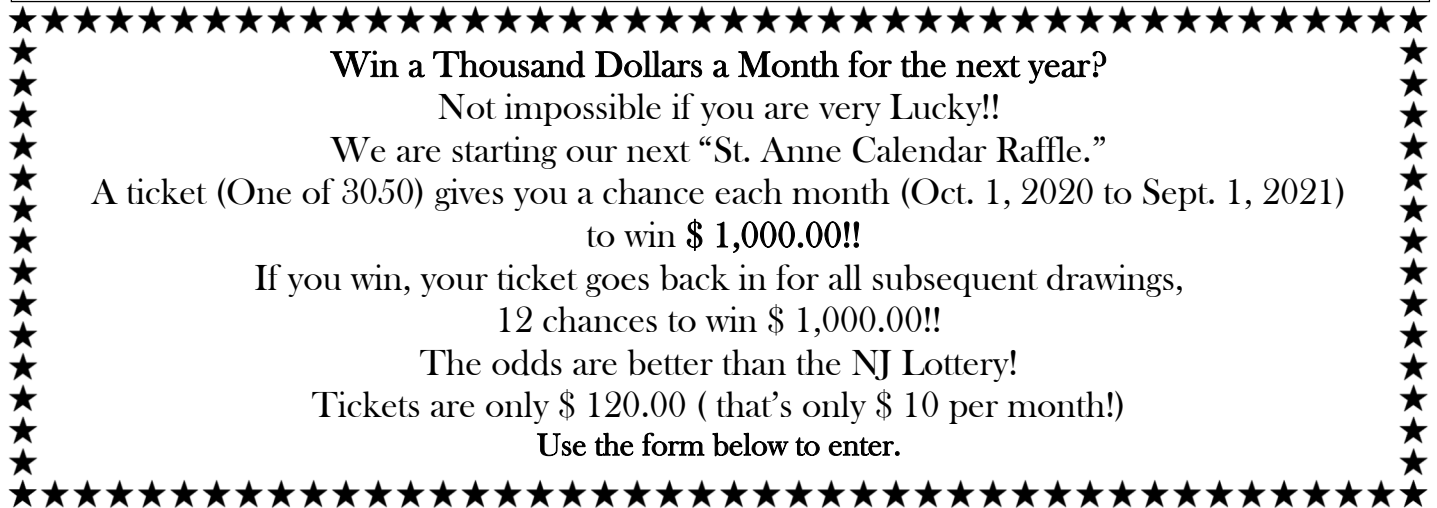
SAINT JOHN MARY VIANNEY (1786-1859)

August 4

A busy pastor jokingly suggests the secret of John Vianney’s holiness: “He died seventeen years before telephones!” Call they didn’t, but visit they did, keeping Vianney eighteen hours a day in the confessional. Stories abound of reading hearts and exorcisms, but Vianney’s first miracle was getting ordained. Difficulty with studies delayed him, prompting the rector’s apology to the bishop, “So far to ordain just one, especially *this* one!” The bishop, who could not know he was ordaining the future patron saint of parish priests, replied, “No burden to ordain one good priest!”

In Ars, only an elderly handful attended Mass, “praying,” one told Vianney, “for a priest with brains.” But he stayed forty-two years, fulfilling the promise he made the day he arrived. In a sculpture just outside the village Vianney points skyward: “Show me the way to Ars,” he tells a boy, “and I’ll show you the way to heaven.” To someone who feared there was no heaven beyond the grave, Vianney smiled, “My child, it would have been heaven enough to have lived as Jesus’ disciple on earth.”
