How do we prepare for His coming?

Full Faith

Sometimes it may look odd that, while the secular world begins to celebrate peace and joy during the holiday season, the Gospel this week is asking us to consider our sinfulness.

"Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand," echoes across the centuries. The words of John the Baptist about sin, God's wrath, and the need for repentance are a bit of a downer as we prepare for Christmas.

Let me explain that Advent has a two-fold character, for it is a time of preparation for the Solemnities of Christmas, in which the First Coming of the Son of God to humanity is remembered, and likewise a time when, by remembrance of his, minds and hearts are led to look forward to Christ's Second Coming at the end of time. For these two reasons, Advent

is a period of devout and expectant delight" (Universal Norms. 39)

Let us celebrate this Advent season full of faith that Jesus will come to us to bring us his glory one day. While waiting, let us re focus our lives on His and follow him. Let us remember that God does not only exist, but he also hears our prayer all the time (24/7). He is Emmanuel, at the Eucharist, now and always.

The visit of Bishop Elias Lorenzo in our parish this 2nd Sunday of Advent brings joy and faith to all parishioners especially to our FBRE parents, children, and catechists.


