Pastor's Notes

"Keep the faith" is one of the famous Irish sayings that came to my mind when I read the Gospel for this week.

Jesus summoned and sent his apostles, two by two to preach the Good News to the world. Though they were not the perfect people for the job, Peter denied him three times, Thomas doubted his victory over death, most deserted him during the crucifixion, Matthew was a tax collector. Many of them have no formal education yet Jesus entrusted to them our faith and the task of continuing his mission here on earth.

Imperfect as they were, Jesus accepted them and used their unique gifts and experiences as stepping stones to become saints.

Take note, the mission that was entrusted to them was not easy. They were instructed not to take anything for the journey - no food, no sack, no money. They can wear a sandal and have a walking stick. No second tunic or extra set of clothing.
