**Vaccine Clinic at St. Anne's
 TODAY: Sunday, June 6
 8:30 to 12:00 Noon**

Westfield Regional Health Department is
 sponsoring a Covid vaccination clinic at
 St Anne's Church (Bethlehem Room) on
 Sunday June 6 from 8:30 am to 12 noon
 for anyone age 18 yrs. and above who
 would like to receive the
 Covid vaccine.

The vaccine is **free**.

No documentation of insurance or
 immigration status is needed.
**It is a walk in clinic, no appointment
 is necessary.**

Open to all age 18 yrs. and above.

Reminders:

- 1. If you are vaccinated,** you need not wear a
 mask while in the church. (The CDC recom-
 mends that non-vaccinated persons wear masks
 in group situations to protect themselves.)
 "Social distancing" is no longer in effect.
 Vaccinated persons: ***Feel free to wear a
 mask in church if you so desire!***
- 2. As of June 4th,** all restrictions as to numbers
 gathering in indoors settings , are removed.
 (Normal maximum numbers are to be followed.)
- 3. As of June 6th,** the obligation to attend Mass on
 Sundays has been re-instated.

In reality, St. Anne's has not been "Over
 crowded" at any Mass! Also, we will continue the
 sanitizing of the church after every service.
