## **Pastor's Notes**

One of my favorite saints is St. Augustine.

He was a highly intelligent man who even tried to fathom the depth of the mystery of the Trinity of God.

One day, while meditating, he saw a child playing in the beach sands, trying to fill a hole with seawater. He told the child that what he wants to do is impossible. The child, who was actually an angel replied that if what he is doing is impossible, it is even less possible for him to try to understand the mystery of the Holy Trinity.

The story of St. Augustine reminded me of a boy whom I would like to call as Little John. His young mind wanted to understand the mystery of the love of God. He had a very simple question about God. Answering it, however was really difficult, even for me as a priest.

He asked "Why God must suffer to save the world when He is almighty and very powerful? With a snap of his fingers, without dropping a sweat, he can totally delete the sins of the world."

I was put in a silent mode for a while and prayed to the Holy Spirit.

The only answer I can think of was John 3:16, "For God so loved the world that he gave his on Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life."

I had to admit that I had to paraphrase to better explain God's saving love. God so loved the world that God sent the Son to be born into the world, to suffer and die so as to atone our sins once and for all and to be raised up so that all may have eternal life.

In the same way, God is also teaching us what true love is by example. True and real love is always willing to suffer and die for the beloved. God is inviting us to love the way He loved, and to participate or give our share in His sacrificial love.

This 4th Sunday of Lent is "Laetare" Sunday. We are told to "Rejoice" because though we cannot fathom how deep God's love for us, I am sure we believe that because of His love, He suffered, died and rose back to life to bring us eternal life.

I pray that this Season of Lent may more and more souls will find solace in the unparalleled love and mercy of God.
