

Dear Parish Family,

In January, the parishioners of the Archdiocese of Newark received an invitation from Cardinal Tobin to participate in the Annual Appeal. The Annual Appeal is an opportunity for all of us to express our gratitude, and to consider our support of the vital ministries that are central to our Catholic mission and our beautiful Archdiocese. In doing so, we continue serving so many people in Christ's name. Your financial support of the Appeal provides education to our future priests, and much more. Be assured that 100% of the funds collected are solely used to support the ministries in the Annual Appeal materials.

Your pledge and gift to this year's Appeal will also help St. Anne's receive possibly two financial incentives. Pledges made by June 30, 2023, that exceed the Stretch Goal of **\$32,331** will make our parish eligible for rebate. The actual rebate amount will be based on the funds collected by December 31, 2023.

Also, if we meet or exceed this goal in funds collected by June 30, 2023, St. Anne's will receive a 2% assessment rate reduction in our parish assessment for Fiscal Year 2024. This is a potential savings for our parish. St. Anne's will use any rebate money or savings towards our parish needs such as repair and maintenance.
