Statement from the Archdiocese of Newark concerning the reopening of Churches

A general dispensation from the Sunday obligation will remain until further notice.

The dispensation for the obligation to attend Mass will remain in effect. No one will be required to attend Mass when public celebrations resume. Hence, live stream Masses for parishioners at home will continue.

Attendance will be limited. We know restrictions will remain on holding large gatherings, so we are working with parishes to determine the best way to ensure safety. Communications will come from the parish so parishioners will know how many people can attend any given Mass.

It is likely that all parishioners may not be able to attend Mass regularly at first.

Social Distancing will be practiced. Expect that your parish will have pews/rows that are taped off, and that households, even of one individual, will be asked to keep six feet of separation from each other. No one will be admitted without a mask. Parishioners should take their temperature before coming to Mass.

Anyone with any symptoms of sickness must stay home.

Liturgical changes will be in place. Similar to protocols established when churches were closing, extra precautions will be taken. Temporary adjustments will be made to how we celebrate Mass and receive Communion.

There still will be a risk for anyone who attends a public Mass. Even with best health practices and strict social distancing, anyone who enters a public space should recognize there is a risk of contracting the coronavirus. Improved cleaning will occur at our churches, but no one should expect that they will be any safer from germs than in other public spaces.

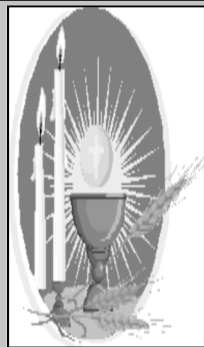

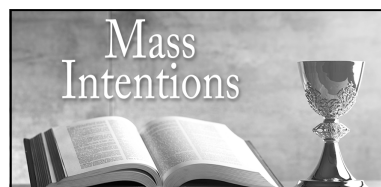

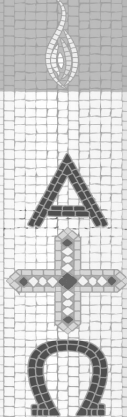

The Church is Re-opening!!

As you have heard, the Archdiocese of Newark is attempting to re-open our churches in an orderly way. **Presently, St. Anne's Church is open for private prayer Sunday through Friday from 9:00 AM until 2:00 PM. Saturdays: 9:00 AM until 5:00 PM.**

In a few weeks, we are hoping to start daily Masses. At that time, we will be able to schedule Funeral Masses and Baptisms. Of course, there will be some limitations and directives for safety.

The last phase will be Sunday Mass.

I would like to make you aware of some of the safety precautions that will be in use.

At all times, you must wear a face mask while in church.

You must sit only in designated areas.

These are the pews that are not taped off.

Also, each pew can have only 3 individuals.

There are blue tape marks at the places you are to sit.

(A couple may sit together and families of 5 or less, may sit together.)

In pews where couples or families are seated, there might be a space for only one individual at the other end of the pew.

(We ask that all use common sense and practice patience & generosity!)

When the Masses begin, all must wear face masks and sit in designated places.

There will be (as we were doing in March) no physical contact at the "Kiss of Peace."

We must come up to Communion orderly, one pew at a time, using the main aisle, starting from the rear of the Church.

There are blue tape marks on the floor for distancing.

Please advance one space at a time as the space in front of you is unoccupied.

Please stand behind the blue tape mark in front of the Priest to receive.

Communion may be received ONLY on the hand.

As you approach the Priest, make a reverent bow of your head, hold out your hands (the right hand cradling the left; palms up.) Receive the Host and say "Amen."

Step to the side, lower your mask and consume the host.

Replace your mask and return by the side aisles.

This might seem awkward for awhile, however, we will get use to it!

As we begin Sunday Masses, there will be more information.

Some other "New Realities!"

The Holy Water fonts are empty and will not be used until it is allowed.

The Missalettes have been removed.

You may take a missalette from the tables outside and bring it to Mass with you each week.

Anything (Missalettes, gloves, scarfs, etc.) left in church will be thrown away!

After each Mass (and each day of visitation for prayer) the church will be sanitized.

If you are ill, please love your neighbor enough to stay at home!!

We will survive!!
