

"I BELIEVE because it is said so."

This expression seems irrelevant to this new generation when young people would always look for a specific answer and concrete evidence.

The Gospel on Transfiguration this Second Sunday of Lent is a visible manifestation of who Jesus is, and the victorious foresight of His glorious Divinity.

Moreover, our God the Loving Father confirms the identity of Jesus with His very words, "This is my beloved Son with whom I am well pleased, listen to Him."

What concrete evidence and specific answer do we still need to to see and hear?

Instead, let us ask ourselves, "Are we listening to Jesus today?" "Are we making the effort to listen to Jesus's voice during this holy season?"

As we journey this 40-days of Lent with prayer, fasting, abstinence and works of charity, let us focus to the glorious Christ, and to the beautiful future waiting for us.

I pray that we all believe, listen and experience His saving love this Holy Season on Lent.
