RELIGIOUS EDUCATION AND SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION

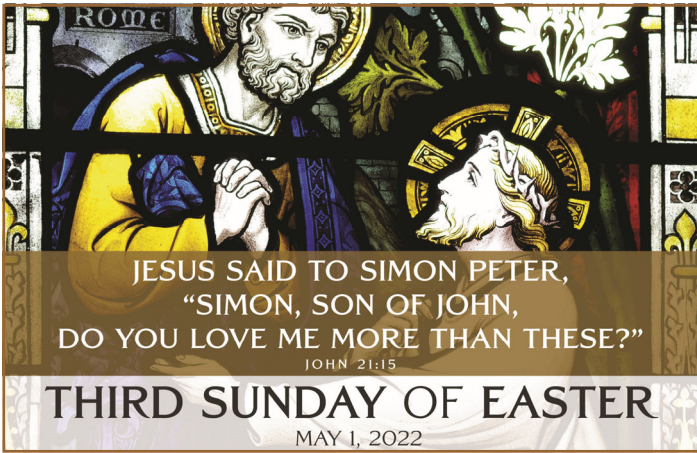
Religious Education classes for children were conducted on Sunday mornings.

REPEATED QUESTIONS

In today’s Gospel, John sets the scene for Jesus’ encounter with Peter, sitting by a “charcoal fire.” There is just one other mention of a charcoal fire in John’s Gospel: when Peter warms himself while awaiting Jesus’ trial, and Peter goes on to deny knowing Jesus, three times.

The evangelist directly links Jesus’ three questions of Peter, “do you love me?”, to Peter’s three denials. Through his repeated questioning, Jesus helps Peter to face his actions fully, and to accept forgiveness fully as well.

When God invites us into prayer, we may be invited to enter into deep conversation with God about our lives.

God can pose the same questions to us, again and again over time, to face what we might prefer to avoid: *Can you forgive someone who has hurt you?*

Can you be more generous?

Can you let go of obstacles to becoming more loving?

And even: *Do you love me?*

PRAYER OF THE WEEK

Third Sunday of Easter

May your people exult for ever, O God, in renewed youthfulness of spirit, so that, rejoicing now in the restored glory of our adoption, we may look forward in confident hope to the rejoicing of the day of resurrection. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever.

Dear Friends,

This is the month of May, dedicated to our Blessed Mother.

Devotion to our Blessed Mother Mary originates in the earliest days of the church. Toward the end of the 18th century, The *Society of Jesus* (Jesuits in Rome) instituted the practice of dedicating the month of May to our Blessed Mother.

From Rome, the May devotion spread throughout the Jesuit colleges, and eventually throughout the whole church.

Pope Pius VII in 1815 granted a partial indulgence for participating in either a public or private devotion honoring Mary during the month of May and Pope Pius IX made the indulgence *plenary* in 1859.

May probably seemed most appropriate since there are several feast days honoring our Blessed Mother:

Our Lady, Queen of Apostles (the Saturday following the Ascension); ***Our Lady of the Most Blessed Sacrament*** (May 13); ***Our Lady of Fatima*** (May 13); ***Mary, Help of Christians*** (May 24); ***Mary, Mediatrix of All Graces*** (May 31); and ***the Visitation*** (May 31).
