""I AM WITH YOU ALWAYS"

"I am with you always" means Emmanuel. This who Jesus is. Our Emmanuel. This is the promise of Jesus which He always fulfills daily and which He fulfilled especially at the coming of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost.

Jesus is always with us in our journey in life both during up and difficult times. He invites us to walk with Him and invites us all to walk together with him.

When the early Church communities needed to resolve certain practical problems or pastoral questions, they held an assembly together, call the Holy Spirit, discussed and discerned with those in authority. During the council of Jerusalem, they discerned if they can allow Gentiles and later on discerned to ordain deacons, and discussed how to take care of widows and orphans with unequal food distribution.

In our modern church today, we are presented with different responsibilities and challenges. Pope Francis is calling the Universal Church to a Synod or "Listening and Discernment" session. He directs the church to convene and work together so as to determine a vision for the future of the Church.

The most basic question we are asked to reflect and explore on is: "What does the Holy Spirit expect of the church in the 21st Century?

The church of St. Anne's will launch our Parish Synod or "listening and Discernment Sessions" on Pentecost Sunday, May 28, 2023, which is also the birthday of the Church. The whole month of June will be designated as "Listening and Discernment Sessions Month" for the general assembly and specific religious groups and associations. Let us build strong our St. Anne's for the next centennial. Let us all participate and pray for the success of our parish synod.
