The sixth Sunday of Easter moves us toward the feast of Pentecost and the coming of the Holy Spirit to the early Church.

Today's Gospel describes Jesus at the Last Supper, foretelling the coming of the Spirit to the community of Jesus. Jesus combines the promise of the Spirit with his gift of peace to his disciples. He foresees that the community must be grounded in his love, which provides peace, to face the tumult of the Crucifixion, and later, the trials of the early Church.

Grounded in Jesus, the community can be then open to the Spirit who will continually guide, remind, and renew them in their life together.

The gift of peace from Jesus is not a worldly peace through which the powerful crush opposition. It is not a complacent or private peace.

The peace of Jesus instead seeks and works toward peace throughout the world, guided by the Spirit.



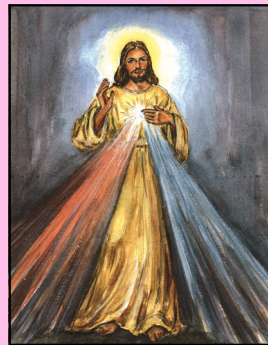
Cardinal Tobin has announced his decision to move the *Feast of the Ascension of the Lord* from Thursday, May 26 to the weekend of May 28-29.

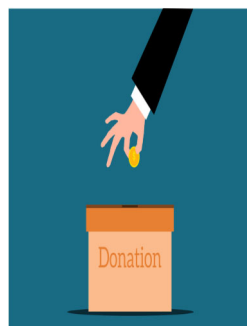
