RELIGIOUS EDUCATION AND SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION

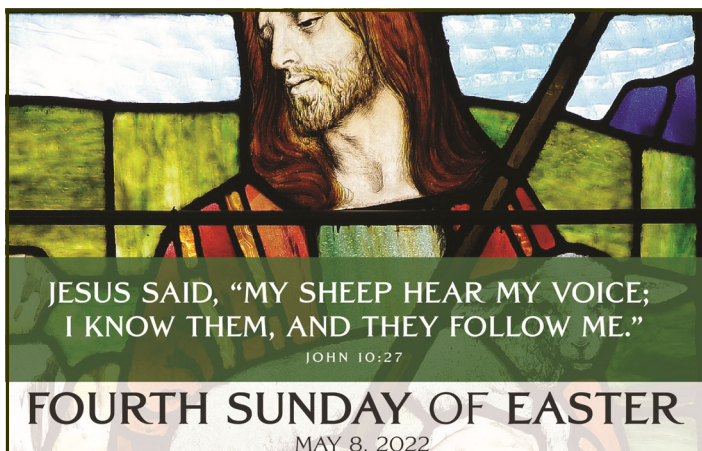
Religious Education classes for children were conducted on Sunday mornings.

In the time of Jesus, when multiple flocks of sheep would be gathered, protecting the flock depended heavily on the shepherd's personal recognition of individual sheep, by sight and sound.
