Is nagging a bad thing? I guess so unless you are nagging God with prayers.

Our 29th Sunday Gospel reading tells us of a parable of a widow who keeps coming back to the judge to demand justice. Finally, because she was persistent, (or shall I say kept on nagging him), the judge gives in to her demand. More than a lesson about nagging, this is

a

lesson that echoes the words of Jesus from other passages: If an indifferent judge can be persuaded to response through persistent appeals, how much more so will our Loving Father respond to his children. And God loves us. Period.

Let us be persistent with our prayers. After all, God knows what we need before we even say them. God reads our mind and heart. Just keep praying to God. Maybe God wants to hear from us more. Besides, it is we who are changed for the better by prayer and not God. What would change in the process is our heart?

Just keep on praying. God knows what is best for us. God knows what is best for you and me. Be persistent in our prayer. We know God is Love and He loves us.
