Some religious education and parish programs resumed, too. (Ours begin next weekend.) No surprise, then, that this weekend's scriptures sound a little like post-summer challenges.

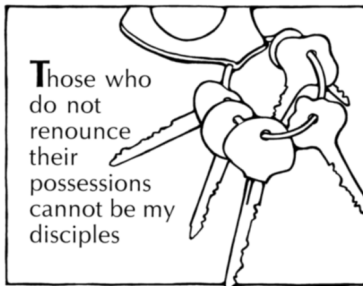
For instance, *Wisdom* reminds us that believers in God can never be content with "timid deliberations" and "unsure plans."

One of the parish surveys showed an interest on the part of parishioners for Scripture Study. Msgr. Ron conducted a 3 week course last Spring that was well received. He will be conducting a 3 week program starting **NEXT Saturday, Sept. 14 at 11:00 AM in the Bethlehem Room.**

We will be reviewing the formation of the Gospels and the other books of the “New Testament” (The Christian Scriptures) and a more intense study of Paul’s First 2 Letters to the Thessalonians.

These letters, dictated around the year 50 AD , are the oldest of all the New Testament writings; predating the earliest Gospel (Mark) about 10 years.

It is a glimpse into the early church!
