Pastor's Notes

Today, we celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King, As followers of Jesus, what does this day mean to us? Really mean to us?

In the Bible, there were many stories about people verbally recognizing Jesus as King. Pontius Pilate for instance, in spite of questioning Jesus' credentials (he was wondering where the latter's kingdom was), still ordered to make a sign for Jesus that says "King of the Jews". There were the big number of people in Jerusalem who eagerly welcomed Jesus as King, waving olive branches as he entered the city. Yet after a few days, turned their backs on him and even condemned him to a brutal and humiliating death.

Then, there's the thief in our Gospel this Sunday. He only heard about Jesus that day but in his last breath, he confidently proclaimed Jesus' authority and humbly asked to be with him.

This week, I encourage each one of us to look deeper into our hearts and reflect on how Christ the King has influenced our lives. Have we openly proclaimed Him even though we haven't seen His kingdom? How did we show our love and allegiance to Him? What kind of subjects are we?

Last Sunday, as I visited the Bethlehem room (named after the birth place of our Jesus), I was deeply moved by the generosity of the people of Garwood. So much food was donated, collected and lovingly sorted by volunteers who gave their time to help our neighbors who are experiencing food insecurity. In my heart, I am witnessing the kingdom of heaven right before my eyes.

Thank you for letting me experience how this small town can have such a big heart.
