Today we celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi or the "Body of Christ". As Catholics, it is our belief that during the mass, the bread and wine are transformed into the actual body and blood of Christ. The Eucharist is the Real Presence of Jesus - Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity.

After consecration, what we partake is no longer a piece of bread or a sip of wine but Jesus Himself. Something that has been continuously proven in numerous occasions throughout the centuries.

Fun fact, the actual feast of Corpus Christi was established in the 13th century by Pope Urban IV, partly in response to a Eucharistic miracle in Bolsena, Italy. During a mass, as the priest held the consecrated host, it is said to have begun to bleed, staining the linen cloth (corporal) upon which it rested while holding the consecrated host. The corporal, along with the other relics is preserved and housed in Orvieto Cathedral, in Italy.

Every day, not just every Sunday, Jesus is inviting us to have a very personal and close communion with Him. Are we excited to accept this invitation?


