This line was made famous by St. Ignatius de Loyola whose feast day we celebrated last July 31st. He was the founder of the religious order, Society of Jesus aka the Jesuits.

Back in the Philippines, the Jesuits are known to own and run a chain of schools and universities where the children of prominent figures in the country (politicians, business people, elite families) go. Some criticized the order for providing quality education only to the upper class. What these critics fail to probe was the real reason behind the prestigious image.

By having these highly coveted and expensive schools, the Jesuits were able to use the profits to fund their other mission programs like providing missionary priests, primary schools and health clinics in small rural villages, college scholarships to gifted students who cannot afford the costs of higher education.

In Today's Gospel, we are challenged to examine our hearts a little deeper. Why do we work so hard to reach our goals and dreams? Is it a sin to be rich?

God did not say that becoming rich with money and material possessions is a sin. In fact, those luxuries are blessings that show how abundant and generous our God truly is. Keeping all the blessings and becoming greedy is the sin.

The more we are blessed, the more we are expected to use and share our blessings to make our world and the lives of people around us better. That way, people will not only know but see and feel the wonders of God.
