

# **Pastor's Notes**

Why do we dedicate the month of June to the Sacred Heart of Jesus?

The story goes...Jesus appeared to St. Margaret Mary of Alacoque in France sometime between 1673 and 1675. On June of 1675, Jesus asked her to spread the devotion to His Most Sacred Heart. He showed her his heart with a cross, surrounded by flames of love, crowned with thorns and with an open wound from which blood flowed.

"Behold the heart which has love men so much and which has spared nothing to the point of exhausting and consuming itself in order to bear witness to its love."



My devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus started when I was 12 years old. I was drawn to the 12 incredible promises made by Jesus to those who have a true devotion to his sacred heart. The 12th one is my favorite.

"I promise you in the excessive mercy of my heart that my all-powerful love will grant to all those who receive holy Communion on the first Fridays in nine consecutive months the grace of final perseverance; they shall not die in my disgrace, nor without receiving their sacraments. My Divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment."

So, at a young age, when I became an altar boy, I tried to be present for the First Friday mass to receive Him in Holy Communion. That is why now that I am a priest, I try my best not to fail in saying mass every first Friday.

Lastly, I pray also that the Divine Heart would be in each member of my family, parishioners and me when the moment comes.

Among the twelve promises, which one is closest to your heart?

Here at St. Anne's we celebrate a mass every First Friday of the month at 8:00 am. Right after the mass is the Eucharistic Adoration and Benediction. I encourage you to come and experience this devotion.
