**Pivic** is a brand-new game with no established players—an open field for anyone to excel. To help you get started, we've set up **four locations in Lexington** where you can test and practice the game. For tournament sign-ups, board locations, and more details, visit <a href="https://playpivic.com">https://playpivic.com</a>. **Boards** are available for public use and can also be purchased. While owning a board isn't required to compete, it's likely advantageous.

**Be prepared to practice!** Don't expect to strike cleanly or grasp strategy without experience. It typically takes **three games to get the hang of it** and many more for precision and strategy. A **playing partner** is highly encouraged to help you improve.

Pivic is a **highly competitive**, **billiards-style game played without a cue stick**, relying on dexterity and shot mastery. The table measures **4 feet by 2 feet** with four corner pockets (*drops*), two centered goals, and a beveled-edge center drop called the **pivic**. The flagship ruleset, "**Attrition**", will be used and is available online. Mastering **strategy**, **angles (wall & bevel)**, **and shot control** will lead to victory—and adaptability doesn't hurt either.

Maximum 120 registrants, some won't show up so be there if you're close on the list and keep an eye on your email either way, conditions may allow for more. Registration has not yet opened and this document will be updated until such time.
