Good evening to all our Okie Scramble couples. We are just a couple of weeks away from the third annual Okie Scramble Couple's Tournament. Since it is based off of the successful Okie Scramble annual event and this tournament the last two years, I believe it will go smoothly. The itinerary (posted on the website) will answer some of the questions you may have, but thought I would add some additional info here that may answer other questions.

Here goes:

- This is a Two-Person Scramble format.
- Tees played are determined based on age and gender (See Rules Sheet).
- There are three flights (Open Flight, Senior A Flight, and Senior B Flight). Each flight has approximately 30 teams. The oldest 60 teams make up the two senior flights, which is flighted based on the opening team handicaps to keep them as fair as possible.
- Using the exact same formula for every team, each team has been assigned an opening team
 handicap, based mainly on the best player on each team, with adjustments made, up or down,
 for their partner. There are some wide disparities in the partner handicaps, but do not panic,
 as adjustments have been limited, since it's a team event.
- Each team will be adjusted (50%), up or down, after each day, based on their performance compared to the average net score in their flight. That should help in giving every team a fair chance to cash.
- We will pay one-third (top 10 spots) in day money each day in each flight. Also, \$200 will be set aside each day for closest to the pin opportunities (\$50 team prize) on all four par 3's each day, and \$300 for skins will be set aside for each flight, each day.
- Also, a very fun and potentially profitable side game will be conducted (Pari-Mutuel). It will be for the three-day total net score in each flight. You may purchase win/place/show tickets on your team or any other team in the tournament. These bets can be placed at the reception Sunday evening and will consist of \$5 minimum bets, and in \$5 increments. I am attaching a betting sheet to this email. After I post the team numbers and flights, you may want to preselect your wagers and bring them with you to the reception. We will have extra sheets there as well.

I hope this letter answers some of the questions you may have had. Don't hesitate to contact me if you have others.

I will post all the tournament docs on the website very soon. I hope everyone has a great time. See you at Santa Ana!
