Introduction

Scholarship Inspiration

The Sadie Grice Funny Scholarship Foundation was created in loving memory of Mrs. Sadie Grice Funny. Mrs. Funny was a native of Georgetown (Plantersville Community), South Carolina. She was educated in the local school system. She later married and had 11 children who were also educated in the local area schools and colleges. Her youngest son, John, is the founder of this scholarship, which he created to honor the contributions and sacrifices that his mother made to educate John and his other siblings.

Scholarship Description, Eligibility & Requirements

Recipients of the scholarship must be a graduating high school senior and enrolling into the college of their choice as a full-time student. All recipients must demonstrate a financial need. Two scholarships in the amount of \$2,000 each will be awarded. Scholarship funds are rewarded on a one-time basis. Past recipients are ineligible to re-apply. Scholarship recipients must live in or around Georgetown, South Carolina. The Scholarship is offered to students attending an accredited college or university in or out of state.

Scholarship Goals and Objectives

The Sadie Grice Funny Scholarship Foundation provides scholarships for students who might otherwise not have the means to pursue, and ultimately achieve, their educational objectives.

Selection Criteria

Scholarship applicants will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- Past academic performance
- Proposed program of study
- A written essay discussing goals and objectives, and reasons for pursuing a degree in the chosen field
- Recommendations from two (2) references
- Their demonstration of financial need
- **WINNERS WILL BE ANNOUNCED AT THE GALA EVENT. All Award Recipient Finalists MUST be able to attend the Sadie Grice Funny Scholarship Foundation Gala event on November 28, 2014 at the Hilton Myrtle Beach Resort located at 10000 Beach Club Drive, Myrtle Beach**

Applicants must be currently enrolled as a full-time student or must have been accepted to attend a full-time undergraduate or graduate program in the next academic year to qualify for a scholarship. The Sadie Grice Funny Scholarship Foundation scholarships are awarded for use in the 2014 Fall or 2015 Spring term of the upcoming academic year.

Terms and Conditions

The Sadie Grice Funny Scholarship Foundation payments will be paid in two installments – immediately paid upon receipt of proof of registration for full-time study at an accredited university or college, and upon proof of registration at the beginning of the second semester or quarter of coursework.

 - 300 – 500 words typed or printed only (no cursive)
 - If typed, at least 1 typed page, single spaced, 12 pt. font
 - Included with the Application
- An official transcript from your high school or each college or university you have previously attended

Your completed application and all of the information listed above must be received by September 2, 2014 if you wish to be considered.

It is the applicant's responsibility to provide full and complete information by the due date. Incomplete submissions will not be considered. Time extensions will not be granted.
