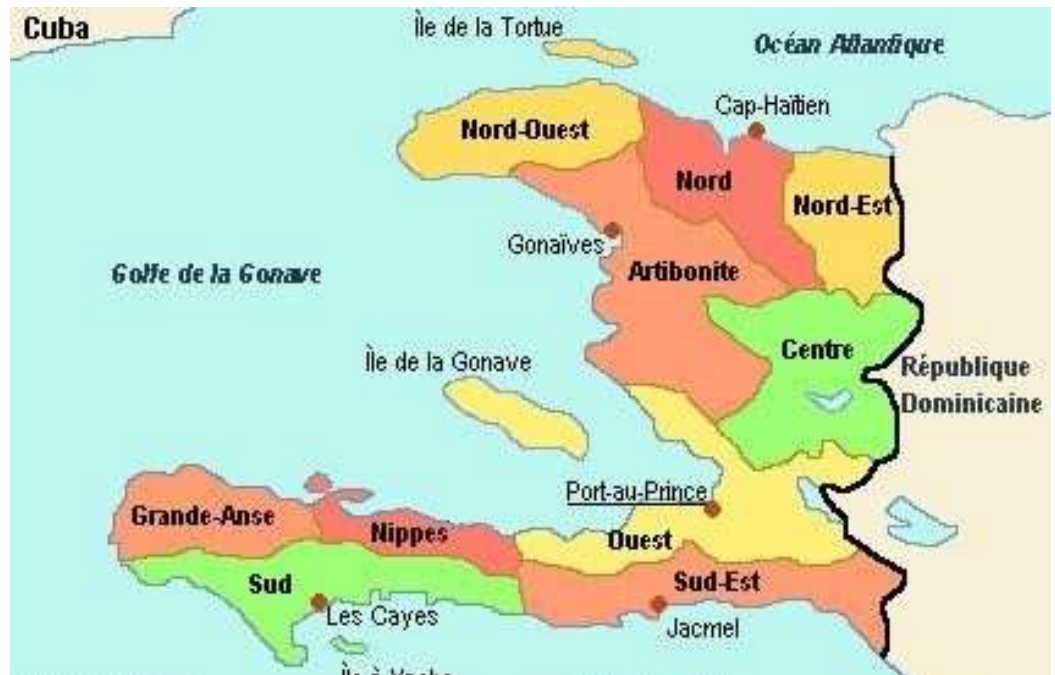
2 government schools, *Lycee Nationale de Cite Soleil*, and *Ecole Nationale de Cite Soleil* currently are the fully functioning schools in Cite Soleil.

This 3 square mile town occupies some 350,000 residents, most of which live in extreme poverty. 2/3 are people under 30. This is exactly the reason that Cite Soleil is ready for economic and legislative changes. .

Administrative divisions

As of 22 July 2015, Haiti is divided into the following:

- 10 [departments](#).
- The departments are subdivided into 42 [arrondissements](#).
- The arrondissements are subdivided into 145 [communes](#).
- The communes are subdivided into 65 [quarters](#).
- The quarters are subdivided into 571 [communal sections](#).



Geographically, the *departments* are the largest territorial divisions, regrouping into *arrondissements* (districts) and *communes* (municipalities). The Arrondissement, encompasses a number of communes. While the Commune is composed of the city, neighborhoods and communal sections are basic territorial subdivisions. Quarters are neighborhoods whose status remain vague, and an ill-defined territory.

COMPUTER ANIMATION Our program starts by teaching the fundamental principles and techniques of animation. Progresses into creating advanced computer-generated virtual models, characters, animations, and visual effects. Students will learn to create 3D computer graphics for video games, commercials, television shows, theme park attractions, and short and feature-length films, all while working through a process that creates a new kind of entertainment industry.



RECORDING ARTS

In music production, songs and soundtracks are recorded, edited, mixed, and mastered. Feature films, television shows, and video games utilize separately created music, sound effects, and dialogue during the final re-recording mixing session to create an immersive multichannel surround mix.



FILM and PHOTOGRAPHY

It takes you through the complete film production process while teaching you the art and science of filmmaking. Learn cinematography, directing, producing, creative writing, editing, sound design, lighting for film and video, production design, and more. From digital video to 16mm, 35mm, and HD, it's an education that teaches you what it takes to create a movie or learn to take award winning photos from the ground up.



DANCE FEVER

The fundamental parts of being a dancer: Classical ballet is the most formal of the ballet styles; it adheres to traditional ballet technique. There are variations relating to area of origin, such as Russian ballet, French ballet, and Italian ballet that will be taught as well. Modern, Contemporary, Jazz, Tap, HipHop and Irish step.



ACROBAT and ATHLETICAS

This is a beginners gymnast class with an edge. Aerials, Back Handsprings, Backward Somersaults, Back Walkovers, Cartwheels, Front Handspring, Front Hip Pullovers, Front Pike Somersaults, Splits, Handstands, Roundoffs, Saltos, Tucks, Swedish Falls and Layouts are the few positions that students will learn discipline and balance.
