An Act to Require Outhouses to Be Removed from Shoreland Zones.

	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

10	7. Outhouses. A person may not construct, use or maintain
	an outhouse in the shoreland zone of a river or great pond, as
12	the shoreland zone is defined by the applicable municipal

	Sec. 3. Application. An outhouse existing on the effective
.16	date of this Act must be removed within one year of the effective

22	This bill prohibits the construction of outhouses in

24	who currently have outhouses in shoreland zones to remove them
