Song Study: Carry Me (song of the unborn child)

The Bible tells us that when God finished making the world in Genesis chapter 1, that He looked at what He had made on the 6th day and declared it to be very good. Everything that we know as the material world, everything in the universe, seen and unseen was made by God and it was very good. Subsequent to that, sin entered the world through Adam and brought the curse of death and corruption into God's good creation. Now we live in a fallen world. Every day of my life was recorded in your book. Every moment was laid out before a single day had passed. **17** How precious are your thoughts about me, O God. They cannot be numbered! **18** I can't even count them; they outnumber the grains of sand! And when I wake up, you are still with me!

You are an expression of God's glory that is intended to reflect His image in the world and to the world. Your Maker knows your name, every day you will live, and when that last day will come. He also knows every life that is born, unborn, or to be born. Jesus loves every life with an everlasting love. He proved that love when He willingly died on the cross to make the way for every life to be redeemed back to God.
